

MALIBU TRAVEL DETAILS

DRIVING FROM SEATTLE:

PHASE 1: CROSS THE BORDER

Around a 2 hour drive to border patrol. This often means leaving around 4:00am.

PHASE 2: DRIVE TO BC FERRY (HORSESHOE BAY)

Around an hour to the ferry terminal after you cross the border. You need to plan on being on the 7:30am or 9:50am ferry to make it to the landing by 12:00pm.

PHASE 3: WAIT TO BOARD FERRY

Depends on how your arrival aligns with the ferry departure.

PHASE 4: RIDE BC FERRY (HORSESHOE BAY - LANGDALE)

About 40 minutes (a beautiful ride!)

PHASE 5: DRIVE TO MALIBU PRINCESS (MALIBU LANDING, EGMONT)

About an hour and half

PHASE 6: RIDE THE MALIBU PRINCESS TO MALIBU!

About three hours

FLYING INTO VANCOUVER AIRPORT:

Same as above besides two additional phases:

PHASE 1: FLY INTO VANCOUVER, BC

Book a flight that arrives on Wednesday, 9/16. There isn't enough time to land, get a rental car and get to ferry by 9:50am. And even if you found an early enough flight, what if it got delayed?

PHASE 2: PICK UP RENTAL CAR AND HEAD TO ACCOMMODATION

It is a 40 minute drive from the airport to the Horsebay ferry terminal, so book an accommodation between the two locations to make your travel easier the next day.

Look above at phases 2-6 for the rest of your journey!



IMPORTANT TIMING:

LANDING → MALIBU | THURSDAY, 9/17

10:00am : Leave Malibu on Princess

1:00pm: Arrive back at Malibu Landing

1:00pm: Earliest ferry you should book

MALIBU → LANDING | SUNDAY, 9/20

12:00pm : Arrive at Malibu Landing

There is free parking here, but leave no valuables in car

1:00pm: Malibu Princess leaves

4:00pm: Arrive at Malibu

WANT TO COME LATER OR LEAVE EARLIER?

You are able to book a **water taxi** that is able to hold 12 people and costs \$550+ dollars.

Sea Planes are an option but are highly discouraged this time of year with flights being canceled.
