- Maintain accurate records and ensure compliance with biosecurity protocols.
- Train and supervise volunteers and interns, helping to maintain the highest standards of care.
- Assist with overseeing management and respect of the provided housing with interns and veterinary students, and be the main point of contact between students and staff for any issues or concerns.
- Assist in maintaining inventory of supplies, equipment, and food.
- Optionally participate in creating social media content for platforms such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, TikTok, and YouTube.

### Qualifications:

- Current rabies vaccination or up-to-date rabies titers (required).
- At least 3 months or 400+ hours of experience in wildlife education.
- Valid driver's license and reliable transportation.
- Ability to stand for extended periods, lift up to 25 lbs., and work in all weather conditions.
- A positive attitude and strong passion for wildlife care.

### What We Offer:

- Duration: 1 year (January-December 2026)
- Housing at BRWC Nest at Stuart Hill Apartments (required)
- Full-Time Position: 40+ hours per week, including weekends and holidays
- Pay: \$800/bi-weekly (before taxes)
