#### **TERMS, CONDITIONS, AND REFUNDS**

(Please read the following carefully before you submit the application form)

- 1. A deposit of \$150 must be paid upon registration in order to reserve a spot. The balance owing must be paid prior to course commencement.
- 2. Students must submit proof of student ID and completion of the pre-requisite course to register for the course. A copy of the student's report card or OST will be accepted.
- 3. There will be \$150 deposit required for a textbook if the course subject requires a textbook in the class. Students will get a refund of \$100 upon the return of the textbook.
- 4. TIA reserves the right to cancel courses at any time due to insufficient enrolment. In the event that a course is withdrawn, students will have priority access to another course or will receive a full refund
- 5. If you withdraw from the course 30 days before the first class, we will fully refund your tuition.
- 6. If you withdraw from the course between 1 to 29 days before the first class, we will refund your tuition less the registration fee of \$150.00.
- 7. The refund process will take 2-3 weeks.
- 8. Once the class begins, there is no refund.

# SCHOOL CONDUCT AND POLICIES

The school requires students to observe the following expectations:

- 5. Disruption of the classroom or learning environment.
- Vandalism of school property.
- 7. Smoking or vaping on school property.

Breaches of these rules including the defiance of school authority will be viewed most seriously and may result in suspension, possibly dismissal. In some cases, it may be appropriate for the school to involve the participation of the Police.
