

COVID-19 Mitigation Plan for Harvest Church

In accordance with the State of Alaska's "Reopen Alaska Responsibly" Phase 2, (5/8/2020) we are permitted to resume in-person services with the following restrictions:

- 1. If you or a family member is sick or has a fever, you must stay home. Additionally, if you are in an at-risk group, we encourage you to continue participating online, until you feel safe enough to come in-person.
- 2. All Social, Religious, and Other Gatherings will be limited to a total number of people, not to exceed 50, including facilitators (staff and volunteers).
 - a. Please be sure to **RSVP** to Sarah Arnold (sarah@harvestak.com) with a total count of people in your household that plan to attend so we can be sure not to exceed our allotted numbers. No children's classes will be available.
 - b. Due to poor internet at the church, we will post the message Sunday evenings (vs. live) so families and individuals who cannot attend in person can still hear the message. Worship will continue to be released online separately, as we are still working out how to properly record music vs. speaking. Tune in during the week on our Facebook and YouTube to worship together.
- 3. 6 feet social distancing is required for non-household members. If your children can sit with you and maintain social distancing, they are also welcome to attend. Unfortunately, until the social distancing restriction is lifted, we will not be able to have children's classes. We will not be providing activities for them at this time.
- 4. Cloth face coverings should be worn, whenever possible.
- 5. We encourage you to wash your hands frequently for at least 20 seconds and will have hand sanitizer available in every room.
- 6. No food or drink will be provided, but you are welcome to bring your own.

We are rejoicing we can see each other in-person and are believing that we will be able to resume regular services again in the near future! Please continue to pray for our state leadership to have wisdom as they plan for the full reopening of Alaska.
