Q. How did you hear about A Friend for You?

A. I heard about A Friend for You from my ex-sister in law.

Q. What sounded most interesting about our services that led you to join?

A. It was how I could get matched with a good friend and to get all of the good services that I need by being a first time parent.

Q. Who was your matched Friend, and how did your relationship with your Friend grow? What would you like to share about her?

A. My Matched friend was Tammy. Our friendship grew strong. What I want to share about her is that she's a really good friend and she even went to my baby shower when I had it. We still have contact with each other and still meet up.

Q!.Why are you sharing about your experience with A Friend for You?

A. I'm sharing... because I love this program. I think it's really good to have it for first time moms or just moms in general. It's always good to have all of the resources and to have [a] matched friend who you can talk with about parenting. And I'm really glad I got to experience this program and to experience this time with Tammy. I highly recommend this program to every pregnant woman out there.

Q. What do you want to say to someone who is pregnant and feeling like she could use some extra support?

A. I would like to say to someone who is pregnant that I highly recommend you to get in touch and contact A Friend for You to get all of the support which you can get and need. It's a blessing and it will help you a lot in the long run. And it will save your life...I got all the support that I needed and wanted and it helped me a lot and saved my life!

Q. How long have you been involved with A Friend for You?

A. Since Feb. 2024 after hearing [A Friend for You] speak at bible study.

Q. What drew you to get involved with A Friend for You?

A. I had been praying for a few months about where I was to volunteer my time. A few of the leaders came to CitiPointe women's bible study and spoke about A Friend for You and what it was about.... I had adopted my oldest son and his birth mother was 16 and I walked through the last three months of her pregnancy with her. Talking to her, taking her to doctor appointments.. I felt this would be a little like that. After praying about it, I knew this was what God wanted me to do!

Q. Have you connected Jessica to any community resources?

A. The biggest resource I connected Jessica to is Marisol Family. They provided her with diapers, formula and preemie clothes. They can go there once a week and get items for the baby. This has been a great resource since they[knew they] were having a preemie and it had been hard to get premie items for the baby.

Q. What kind of growth have you seen in Jessica?

A. I enjoy seeing the strength she has shown. She went through a long labor which ended in a c-section. She had a preemie baby girl but has shown such strength in taking care of her and allowing herself to heal. She is enjoying everything that sweet little baby is doing everyday as she grows and gets stronger. [Jessica] isn't getting frustrated with the lack of sleep but rejoices in all that she sees the baby learning to do everyday!

Q. What do you specifically enjoy about being a volunteer?

A. I enjoy the time I spend investing in others, it not only blesses them but it blesses me. It reminds me that we are not meant to live life alone but to walk beside others, to pray for and with others that God puts in our lives.
