DESTINATION WEDDING PLANNING LIST

12+ MONTHS TO GO

- I. Work out your budget. (don't forget travel expenses like airfare and accommodations.)
- 2. Draft up your guest list.
- 3. Decide on a country or area you'd like to get married in.
- 4. Talk about marriage license options since they vary from country to country.
- 5. Make sure you have needed passports and documents.
- 6. Hire a planner.
- 7. Book a travel agent that specializes in destination weddings.
- 8. Secure a wedding venue and set your date!
- 9. Check if you need wedding insurance (some venues require it.)
- 10. Reserve your honeymoon suite.

9-II MONTHS TO GO

- I. Recruit your bridal party.
- 2. Send out Save The Dates.
- 3. Set up a hotel room block for wedding guests.
- 4. Create a wedding website that includes details on travel and accommodations.
- 5. Plan any additional wedding-related events.
- 6. Create your gift registry.
- 7. Purchase your wedding day attire
- 8. Purchase your airline tickets. Get those earlybird deals!
- 9. Work with your wedding planner or venue coordinator to find vendors.

6-8 MONTHS TO GO

- I. Take engagement photos.
- 2. Create the menu.
- 3. Book the rehearsal and rehearsal dinner location.
- 4. Schedule your dress fitting and get your bridal party attire.
- 5. Order the wedding invitations.
- 6. Set dates and locations for bridal showers and bachelor/bachelorette parties.
- 7. Book wedding-day transportation, if needed.
- 8. Book the rest of your vendors.

3-5 MONTHS TO GO

- I. Finalize the guest list and get the invitations out!
- 2. Start scheduling any informal recreational activities.
- 3. Purchase wedding rings and accessories (such as veil, wedding shoes, and undergarments).
- 4. Finalize honeymoon plans.

DESTINATION WEDDING PLANNING LIST

6-8 WEEKS TO GO

- I. Finalize and confirm the hoel bookings, readings, photography shot list, menu, rentals, etc.
- 2. Get any required vaccines before traveling to your destination.
- 3. Make sure you have all the necessary legal documents ready.
- 4. Order wedding favors for your guests.
- 5. Buy gifts for the wedding party and parents.
- 6. Arrange welcome bags for your guests.

3-5 WEEKS TO GO

- I. Send anything you can't take with you to your on-site wedding coordinator
- 2. Pick up your wedding rings.
- 3. Have your final dress fitting.
- 4. Check in with any guests who haven't RSVP'd yet.
- 5. Start putting a packing list together.

I-2 WEEKS TO GO

- I. Pick up your gown.
- 2. Confirm flight numbers and arrival times for all the key players in your wedding.
- 3. Finalize seating arrangements and have a seating chart or place cards created.
- 4. Put together a Bridal Emergency Kit.
- 5. Check the weather report.
- 6. Start packing!
- 7. Figure out tips and final payments for vendors.
- 8. Schedule a massage.

4-5 DAYS TO GO (ONCE YOU ARRIVE)

- I. Do a walk-through of your ceremony and reception venue.
- 2. Meet with your coordinator and other vendors.
- 3. Get your marriage license.
- 4. Have a tasting with your caterer/cake maker.
- 5. Make sure welcome bags will be delivered to guests' rooms.
- 6. Do a makeup & hair trial.
- 7. Enjoy a mani-pedi.
