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WHAT TO BRING

- Bible, pen, and journal
- Pillow & sleeping bag (or twin bedding set)
- Clothes & shoes for water games (dark shirts)
- Sunscreen and bug spray (please make sure your camper knows the how, when and why of their proper application)
- Swimwear (for girls: one piece)
- One set of clothes that can be disposed of on site (messy games)
- Snacks
- Outfits for theme nights: "Stone Age" - Come dressed as caveman, cave woman, or dinosaur // "Night At The Zoo" - Come dressed as your favorite zoo animal! i.e. zebra, tiger, or kangaroo // "Thrifty Prom" - Go to a thrift store or through your parent's closet and come dressed up in a gown or suit
- Sneakers (comfortable) are required to participate in some activities.
- Comfortable clothes – 4 sets of shorts and t-shirts (Do not bring clothes that are revealing, spaghetti straps or strapless tops, short shorts) Clothes will get dirty.
- Pajamas
- Toiletries – wash cloth, 1-2 towels (showers and pool), shower shoes, toothpaste, tooth brush, shampoo/conditioner, soap, personal toiletries
- Medications – Make sure your child's medication release form is complete and all medications are in original container(s) in a ziploc bag marked with child's name
- Reusable water bottle

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Cell phones, electronic devices of any kind
- Expensive jewelry or anything of value.
- Matches, lighters, or fireworks
- Spray paint, water guns, silly string, water balloons, etc...
- Alcohol, drugs, illegal substances, tobacco products, e-cigarettes, or weapons
