So now you...are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God's holy people. You are members of God's family. Ephesians 2:19 (NLT)


2. Pure love came...and I am not ______.

[GROW]

When you think of Mary, Joseph, the shepherds, etc. you realize they were just ordinary, regular people and yet God chose them. How does it make you feel to know that God has chosen you?

Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-28. How would you explain this to someone using yourself as an example?

[LEAD (Yourself)]

Have 3 different people read Luke 2:8-14 out loud. Try to imagine yourself present that night with the shepherds. What would it have felt like? What would you say? What would you do? Use that as a way to engage your heart fully into this Christmas season.
