TRIPLE R RANCH

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CAMPS:

Adventure Camp – Campers rotate through Morning Skill Area activities each morning with their cabin mates through a different schedule of skill areas each day (see Morning Skill Areas below.) Afternoons are spent at the pool, climbing wall, playing games, at an optional elective (additional fees - see registration form) or hanging out with friends at the camp store, the “Trading Post.” In the evening, Bible Discovery hour and camp-wide programs round out the day. (Sunday at 5:00PM through Friday at 5:00PM.)

Mini Camp – Campers experience a shorter version of Adventure Camp. (Sunday at 5:00PM through Wednesday at 5:00PM.)

Day Camp – Campers enjoy the best Morning Skill Area activities and their own Bible Discovery hour and time in the camp store, the “Trading Post” in the afternoon while spending their overnights at home. See each camp date for specific ages. (Mon-Fri 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM each day.)

HORSEMANSHIP ELECTIVES: Ages 8-14. For Adventure and Day Camp ONLY.

Additional Fees apply (see front of form):

Horsemanship Morning Track – This is for campers who want to spend more time with horses and go further in their horse handling skills. Two hours each morning of the week are spent at the stables learning to ride and take care of horses.

Private Riding Lesson – A one-on-one horseback riding lesson tailored to the individual’s needs (limited to one lesson per camp session).

Additional Trail Ride – A 45-minute group horseback trail ride (limited to one lesson per camp session).

MORNING SKILL AREAS: Campers travel with their cabin mates through a schedule of exciting Skill Areas. The following is an

example of what to expect:

Air Soft – Target shooting

Archery – Campers master the bow and arrow with time at the archery range.

Canoeing – Campers get on the river to explore and perfect their strokes.

Challenge Course – Cabins work together to overcome the challenge of our low ropes course.

Climbing Wall – Scale to the top of our 40 ft. high climbing tower and ring the bell.

Critter Corral – Meet our small farm animals and learn why each one is important.

Escape Room – Gather clues and solve a mystery as a group.

Flying Squirrel – Strap in a full body harness and experience a moment of “flying” with the help of teammates on the other end of a harness and pulley system.

Horse Sense – Learn what is involved in grooming, saddling and staying safe around horses.

Horseback Riding (ages 8-14)/Pony Rides (age 7) – Every camper gets the opportunity to mount up and take a ride.

Laser Tag – Experience the excitement of laser tag with multiple modes of game play.

Nature – Become more aware of our environment as you study what can be found in nature.

Swimming Pool – Enjoy the Water Slide, swimming, diving boards, and games at the pool.

Wallyball – This fun indoor game is like volley ball in a racquetball court.
