


Welcome I'm glad you're here.





Style Guide

NEUTRALS ARE BEST

Choosing a neutral colorway for your outfits is always a great option. Depending on your location, natural elements or murals can often be highlighted by wearing neutrals over bright colors.

TEXTURE OVER PRINT

Similar to bright colors, loud and busy prints can be very distracting. By including a variety of textures (i.e. denim, soft sweater, linen dress) the focus is kept on you as a couple and eyes aren't drawn to a overpowereing print.

COMPLIMENTARY NOT MATCHING

Select colors that compliment each other, but don't do exact color matching! Choosing clothing that is in the same colorway as your partner will create that connection without being too cheesy.

DRESS COMFORTABLY

Yes, look fashionable, but make sure your articles of clothing are also comfortable! If you don't feel confident in what you're wearing (i.e too tight, too loose, short skirt, itchy fabric), your discomfort will show through your expressions in images.

The first step in creating your dream day

THE BREAKDOWN

The first step in planning your wedding timeline is always searching when the sun will set on your wedding day. You can determine this with a quick Google search.

Plan your your cermony to be at least 2 hours before the sunset. Fall and Winter weddings, this allows for a 1/2 hour ceremony, family photos, and couples portaits. Spring and Summer weddings, this allows for the above but also an additional time during the reception at sunset for more couples portraits.

Family and bridal party photos always take more time than people think, and aloting more time for these portions of your day will make everything feel less rushed and hectic.

Schedule times for yourselves! Whether it be a bathroom break or 10 minutes for you and your new spouse to walk around your venue's grounds, take the time needed to soak in and savor this trumendous day!



Leading up to the Big Day

EMERGENCY PLAN

Stuff happens! In case I have a last minute emergency, I will entrust my second shooter to take over all photographic duties for your wedding day, and if needed, find another photographer with a similar shooting style. A \$200 discount will be applied from total cost. I will still edit and review all images that you will receive.

ONE MONTH BEFORE

The digital pre-wedding questionairre will be sent your way. This will be a series of questions to help us learn more about your schedule for the day, family circumstances, etc. I will also corespond with your wedding planner, if any, during this time.

TWO WEEKS BEFORE

Your pre-wedding questionairre should be completely filled out.

ONE WEEK BEFORE

All invoices must be paid and any last minute questions/requests can be asked and discussed.





The Aftermath

WHEN YOU WILL RECEIVE IMAGES

Your full gallery will be sent to you 4-6 weeks after your wedding day, depending on the date/season your wedding is in. 10-15 sneak peak images will be sent the week after your wedding, just to give you a taste of all that is to come.

ONLINE GALLERY

Sneak peaks and the full gallery will be sent through the online gallery website, PASS galleries. All images are downloadable directly through the website and there are also options available for printing images through the site. For printing and sharing, I recommend downloading with the high-res option!

SHARING YOUR IMAGES

Your full digital gallery can now be shared with your friends and family. If you choose to share on social media, please tag the BC Media Photos social accounts.
