

The composer is the person who creates the music. This usually refers to the music in songs, but it can also include underscoring.

The lyricist creates the words, also known as the lyrics. The job of the lyricist is a lot more challenging than simply finding words that fit the music. Good lyrics can reveal character, progress a plot, establish a time and place, or some combination thereof.
