WHAT EVERY *amily* NEEDS TO KNOW

I'M SO EXCITED FOR YOUR FAMILY SESSION! I feel so honored to capture this special time in your life and cannot wait to document this stage you are in. This guide was created to help you get the most out of your session, and by the time you read through this, I hope all of your questions will be answered and you will feel more than prepared. The most important thing I want you to remember is to have fun, laugh a lot, and enjoy the moment because as the saying goes, 'the days are long, but the years are short'. These photos we create together will be something you cherish forever!





#### Choosing a time & date

I AM A NATURAL LIGHT PHOTOGRAPHER BECAUSE I BELIEVE that natural light, from the sun and it's reflections creates photographs that feel timeless and truest to you. I begin portrait sessions 1-2 hours prior to sunset during the "golden hour" when the light is the dreamiest. To get the most out of your session, it is helpful if you plan a buffer when getting ready so you can arrive a few minutes early to your session and be ready to start on time. I am only able to shoot when natural light is in the sky, so we will want to take advantage of every minute.



I typically do not shoot family sessions during weekends due to wedding bookings. However, if you are unavailable for a weekday session, contact me and I will add you to a weekend waitlist if I have any openings.

# FOR THE FAMILY



#### COORDINATING the crew

As your are coordinating your family outfits, I recommend that you avoid thinking about "matching" and instead think of what "fits". The goal for coordinating outfits is essentially to break up the colors and shades so that you are not all wearing the same color on top and on bottom. I encourage you to think about planning each outfit with "dominate colors" and "accent colors" in mind. A dominate color is a color that you see most in an outfit, while an accent has a smaller piece of visual real estate. When choosing the colors for your outfits I always suggest going with neutral earthy and/ or soft tones. You'll want to compliment the environment, not clash with it. I love olive green, navy blue, burnt orange, black, cream, maroon, mustard yellow, etc. Textures are always a good idea... lace, raised patterns, fringe etc. Lastly, it's best to avoid all logos and wording on clothing. It draws the eye immediately to the logo instead of your gorgeous faces!

LING I MAN

Mixing up different pieces of your family's wardrobe will bring a great visual interest to your photos. So, don't feel like you have to put all of your children in the same type of outfit. For example, one of your daughters could wear a dress and flats, while the other could wear a skirt and boots. Or, one of your sons could wear a bowtie while the other wears suspenders.
