


Thank you for your interest in the Lyndsay Almeida Photography Retreat, hosted by Casa Erica Travel.

We base the retreats at our home, Casa Erica, a restored former Jesuit monastery set in the beautiful, thriving little town of Lubriano, Umbria. Our property overlooks Civita di Bagnoregio, famously known as Italy's Dying City.

The town is built on top of Etruscan ruins. It was was the regional hub for crafting the pottery vessels used to store herbs and medicines in medieval times, and remains rich in history and beauty.



We are an hour north of Rome, and two hours south of Florence, by train, and a 20 minute drive from Orvieto. Lubriano is a village of 800 people dating from the 12th century.

We have several tiny grocery stores, a variety of charming and excellent restaurants, a post office, a hairdresser, a pharmacy, two coffee shops, and two beautiful Renaissance era churches.

COST

Double Occupancy

Starting at \$3550 per person

Single Occupancy

Starting at \$4050 per person

- A \$1000 non-refundable deposit is due upon registration
- \$1000 is due on 90 days before, with the balance due 60 days before the start of the retreat.
- We will send reminders on the appropriate dates.
- Please inquire if you would like to discuss a custom payment plan.
- Airfare and train transfers to Lubriano are not included.

FAQ'S

How do I get to Lubriano?

You'll be flying into Rome. If possible, we encourage our guests to spend at least one night in Rome before the retreat. On the day the retreat begins, you'll take the one hour train from Rome, where we'll meet you at the Orvieto train station.

What if I don't want to participate in the photography lessons?

That's absolutely fine! On every retreat we have a handful of guests who come just to enjoy authentic Italy. All of the excursions are to fabulous locations, which you'll enjoy either with or without a camera. And if you'd rather just stay in the village and read a book in the garden under the fig tree, you can do that too!

Cancellation Policy

- 1.90+ days before the trip full refund given except for deposit
- 2.45-89 days before the trip 50% of total retreat cost refunded
- 3. There are no refunds for cancellation within 45 days of the retreat.
- 4. We recommend all our guests obtain trip insurance, to include retreat, air, and other costs, as soon as the deposit is made.

TRAVEL

We recommend that you fly into Rome (Leonardo da Vinci–Fiumicino Airport | FCO) airport. There are many trains from Rome to Orvieto. We will help you secure a train ticket, and pick you up from the train station. For a fee, we can also arrange private transportation from and back to Rome. Most guests choose to stay in Rome for a weekend or more before or after the retreat. While planning for Rome is not included in the retreat price, we can send you some recommendations upon request.

HOW TO BOOK YOUR FLIGHT

You will be flying into FCO airport in Rome. You will most likely need to connect to a larger airport, such as New York, LAX, Atlanta, Charlotte, etc., in the US. Flying to Rome from the US will require an overnight flight. Flights return to the US in the daytime. We ask that you not book a flight out before 11 am on the final day unless you plan on a private transfer.
