Cost/Fees

There are 2 terms in the 2025-2026 dance season.

1st Term: September-December 2025 = 15 classes.

2nd Term January-April 2026 = 15 classes.

30 classes in total for the 2025-2026 season.

Cost:

- **30 Minute Class = \$120.00 per term.**
- **45 Minute Class = \$180.00 per term.**
- **60 Minute Class = \$210.00 per term.**

Registration Fee:

- **\$25.00 per student.**
- **\$40.00 per family.**

Festival Fee: \$30.00 per student per dance genre. Festival fees are due December 1st, 2025.

Costume Fee: \$130.00 per student per dance genre. (Excluding Ladies in Belly Dance).

Solos, Duets and Trios

Solos, duets and trios are taught privately, outside of regular dance class times. You must contact Miss V (Véronique - Dance Instructor) on your own to plan arrangements for instruction and payment for private lessons.

Attendance

- **Attendance will be taken each class.**
- **Students that have an injury are encouraged to attend and watch dance class, even if the student cannot dance.**
- **Students that are ill or not feeling well are advised to stay home to avoid getting other students sick, including the dance instructor.**

- Anyone unable to attend dance class, please notify me/Miss V (Dance Instructor) as soon as possible.
- Dance students are required to wear proper dance gear in class and their hair must be tied up and off their face.

Additional Rules

- No jewelry is to be worn in dance class at any given time and must be removed before class begins.
- Absolutely no chewing gum in class!
- No nail polish on the hands or feet for dance performances, festivals, and recitals.

Behaviour Rules

- Misbehavior is NOT tolerated in dance class. If a student becomes a disruption or disobeys in class, the child may be asked to and/or be told to go sit in a Time-out.
- If the problem continues, I will contact and notify the parent/guardian to address the issue.
