



HOW TO PICK THE PERFECT FRENCH BULLDOG BREEDER



DNA TESTING



Ensure you are dealing with a breeder that understands the DNA makeup of the parents.

It's very important and provides you with peace of mind and confidence in your decision.

Breeders should proactively test their dogs for any underlying health conditions.

Additionally, it's important in creating preventative health plans for your dog and choosing the best fit for you.





All My Pawesome Frenchie puppies undergo an independently tested DNA test.

This test screens for over 250 inherited diseases and traits with 99% accuracy.

Additionally, it tests for coat length and colour.

Having an intensive DNA test provides peace of mind in knowing what potential health risks your dog could have as they age and how to create a preventative health care plan.

It also tests for Cystinuria type 3. Cystinuria type 3 is an inherited disease that affects kidney disease and can cause urinary stones. Typically not included in DNA tests, testing for C3 allows you as the potential owner to understand the unique challenges that could be present if you choose a Frenchie with a likelihood of C3.





WAITING LIST DEPOSIT



Be aware of breeders requiring a large amount of money, typically \$500+, with no outline of the terms to be added to the waitlist.

Here at MPF, we charge a \$150 fee to be on the waitlist. This non-refundable fee allows approved families to have first pick of the puppies that become available before they are shown publicly on social media or our website.

The waitlist fee is not put towards the final purchase price of the puppy.



COMMUNICATION



POSITIVE COMMUNICATION TRAITS OF A BREEDER

Does the breeder provide clear, concise and detailed answers?

Is the breeder open to video calls with the puppy as it grows?

Do they answer your questions in a timely manner?

Do they send you updates on the puppy's health, growth and learning?

Questions to ask potential breeders:

- How do you communicate with your clients?
- How often do you communicate with your clients?
- Do you allow visits with the puppy before they are homed? If so, how often?

Is it kibble?

Both options are suitable for the
dog and it is important to
understand the difference between
the types of foods, what works best
in your lifestyle and the potential
transition once the puppy comes
home with you.





Here at **My Pawesome Frenchie**, we raise our dogs on a RAW food diet for many reasons.

One of the main reasons is that it is biologically appropriate for what they would have in the wild.

Additionally beneficial for weight management, dental hygiene, and little to no gas or strong-smelling poop.

It makes it much easier to train the puppy to use the bathroom outside.

Five years later, **My Pawesome Frenchie** has an active and outgoing community, homing Frenchies with loving families all over North America.

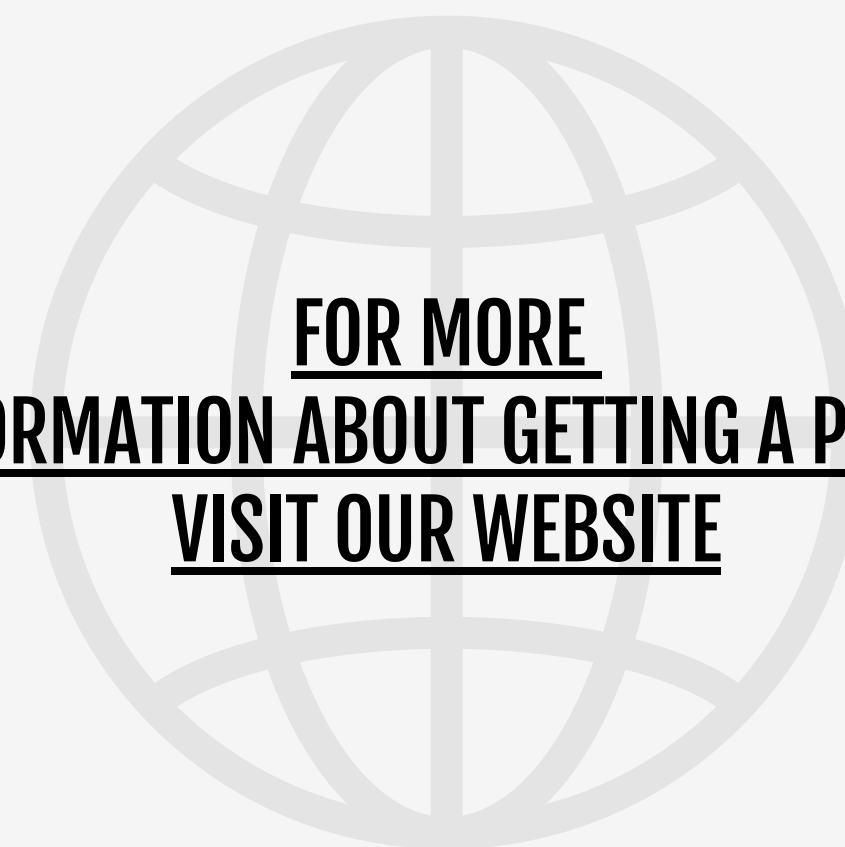
