

TABOR LUTHERAN CEMETERY ASSOCIATION
RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Inasmuch as the owners of lots or graves acquire only the right to burial of the dead and the erection of suitable monuments or markers, the location, size, material, design, construction, and color of such monuments or markers, and of any other structure, implement, or planting placed at the Cemetery shall be subject to approval by the Executive Committee.
2. No enclosure of any nature such as fences, copings, hedges, or ditches shall be allowed around any lot.
3. Grave mounds are not permitted and no lot shall be raised above the established grade.
4. Each and every lot or grave shall be used solely and exclusively for the burial of human beings only.
5. Planting of shrubs, evergreens, and trees is not allowed. A small planting, if the lot is large enough and in conformity with general scheme of the Cemetery may be considered, if such are beneficial to the general appearance of the Cemetery. No planting of any kind is allowed on a designated cremation plot.
6. The Executive Committee or those in charge of the grounds have the right at all times to enter upon each and every lot for the purpose of removing any shrub, evergreen, flower, or anything becoming unsightly or to remove any branches or roots which become detrimental to the adjacent lot or avenue.
7. It is the responsibility of the lot owner to keep the planting trimmed and generally cared for and the Association reserves the right to remove or trim any such planting at the expense of the lot owner.
8. All work in the Cemetery is to be done by workmen employed by the Association or any Contractor authorized by the Executive Committee.
9. The foundations of all monuments or markers are to be laid to a suitable depth. All foundations must be left 1 to 2 inches below the surface grade.
10. No permission shall be given for the opening of a grave, laying of a foundation or any other work to be done in any lot or grave unless such lot or grave is free of all taxes, liens, assessment or indebtedness of any kind to the Association.
11. Driving of any vehicles within the Cemetery at a rate in excess of five miles per hour is prohibited. Vehicles are not to turn around upon any road and not to drive on the lawn.
12. All corner stones must be level with the grade of the lot and set by the Association.
13. No dogs are allowed in the Cemetery.
14. No children are allowed in the Cemetery unless accompanied by an adult.
15. All waste or rubbish of all kind shall be deposited in the proper receptacles placed about the Cemetery grounds.
16. All persons visiting any lot shall respect the solemnity of the Cemetery; and no loud noises or disorderly conduct shall be permitted upon any road, walk, path or any portion of the Cemetery grounds.
17. A minimum of forty-eight hours notice must be given for the opening of a grave.
18. Funerals shall not be held on any legal holiday, or on any Sunday except by special permission of the Executive Committee, in which event there shall be an extra charge.
19. Every certificate or deed of lot will be subject at all times to such rules and regulations as may from time to time be determined by the Executive Committee, and no sale or transfer of any lot, or part of lot shall be valid without the approval of the Executive Committee.
20. Flags shall be permitted on the graves of war veterans on Memorial Day and Veteran's Day and at no other time, except with the approval of the Executive Committee, and shall be removed promptly after such holiday. Flag holders may be located only as directed by the Superintendent.
21. Grave blankets/boxes and artificial flowers are permitted during the winter months, but must be removed prior to March 15th.
22. Property owners are responsible for any form of vandalism to monuments on their property.
23. Only flat, ground level grave markers are allowed in the new section of the Cemetery, which is located at the northern end of the Cemetery and encircled by the access road. Marker size shall be subject to approval by the Executive Committee.
24. A specifically designated cremation plot can only contain the remains of 1 individual and only be marked with a flat, ground level grave marker with a size of 12 inches by 24 inches.
