# ABOUT US...

## MISSION STATEMENT

MoveFwd is on a mission to ensure that every youth has access to low-barrier mental health care and safe and supportive housing.

## COMMUNITIES

MoveFwd services all of the west metro suburbs, with a special focus on Hopkins, Eden Prairie, and St. Louis Park. MoveFwd supports the youth of these communities primarily through school based services in the local middle and high schools.

## LOCATION

MoveFwd is located in Hopkins and our service area is the geographical community of the west metro suburbs. As a long-time advocate for youth, MoveFwd acts as a vital community partner supporting youth and families.

## WHO WE SERVE

MoveFwd serves youth and young adults ages 12 to 24 years of age. With a focus on those youth who identify as low income and/or black, indigenous, and people of color youth. About 66% of the youth who access MoveFwd mental health services identify as BIPOC; within our programs for youth experiencing homelessness, this number exceeds 90%. In terms of gender, 64% of MoveFwd participants identify as female, 32% as male, and 4% as transgender, gender fluid or gender non-conforming. The young people we support come from under-resourced households and need community support to access mental health services and/or transition from homelessness to housing security.

# MoveFwd offers a holistic suite of services designed to meet the needs of the communities we serve:

**MoveFwd Youth Mental Health Services.** MoveFwd provides cost-free, accessible therapy services for middle and high school students within four west metro suburban school districts and for young adults who are experiencing homelessness and housing instability. We offer both individual therapy and therapeutic groups related to depression, anxiety, substance use, stress, family conflict, and wellness. MoveFwd's therapists utilize narrative, cognitive behavioral, attachment, art, and mindfulness-based approaches that are youth-centered and trauma-informed. Our model increases access to quality mental health care for low-income and BIPOC youth.

**MoveFwd outreach, drop in and case management services to help youth successfully resolve their housing crisis.**

MoveFwd provides comprehensive supports to youth who are experiencing homelessness or housing instability. As part of Streetworks, MoveFwd's Outreach Case Managers provide supplies, referrals, and hands-on case management support to youth wherever they are- on the streets, public transit, libraries, food shelves, and in local schools. In addition to outreach services, MoveFwd operates a Drop-in Center that provides low-barrier access to case management, therapy, and basic needs such as food, hygiene supplies, showers, laundry, transit passes, and warm clothing and bedding. MoveFwd Case Managers use a harm-reduction approach and work collaboratively and intensively with each youth to assess their needs and goals, reduce exposure to danger and exploitation, access safe temporary shelter, and find and move into affordable housing.

**MoveFwd Transitional Living Program to help young adults transition from homelessness to housing stability.** The Transitional Living Program (TLP) provides 24 months of subsidized rental assistance and case management for single and/or parenting youth, ages 18-24. A unique feature of our TLP is the utilization of a scattered site model which allows the youth to find housing of their choosing and prevents a housing transition at the end of the subsidized period. All TLP participants receive intensive case management to progress on goals focused on growth areas, employment skills, budgeting, household management, healthy relationships, parenting skills, and mental health and wellness. Many TLP participants also schedule regular individual sessions with MoveFwd's therapists to further build their coping skills, to better understand and manage their trauma history, or to work through challenges of daily life. At the end of their time with MoveFwd TLP, youth have the financial, social-emotional, and independent living skills they need to maintain housing security.

**MoveFwd Upstream Hopkins (pilot: 2020-2022)** A school and community-based early intervention aimed at preventing youth homelessness and school disengagement by identifying students with known risk factors for homelessness and connecting the youth and their families with prevention services. The program uses a universal screening process to identify students in need of resources as early as possible so their needs can be addressed proactively and preventatively. Chapin Hall at the University of Chicago provides the evidence-based Upstream screening tool and service model, the Hopkins School District administers the student screening and provides referrals, and MoveFwd delivers three tiers of youth and family homelessness prevention services based on risk level. Youth and family case management, youth and family therapy, and direct financial assistance keep vulnerable students securely housed so that they can concentrate on school and prepare for a smooth transition into adult independence.
