Do you have a special heirloom item like your grandmother's wedding ring or a special handerkerchief that are a part of your wedding? Include them with your bridal details.






STYLING ITEMS

CUSTOM HANGER

Have the bouquets and boutonnieres delivered to the location where you will be getting ready 30 minutes before I am scheduled to arrive to ensure they are ready to be captured when I get there.

Have an extra copy of your wedding invitation suite made for me to photograph. this makes a lovely image for the opening of your wedding album as it tells the details of your day

TIP 3

Have all your rings (engagement & wedding) included with your details so I can photograph them all together! Don't worry if you are not getting ready at your venue, I can take your rings from you when you go for your wedding breakfast and photograph them whilst you eat.
