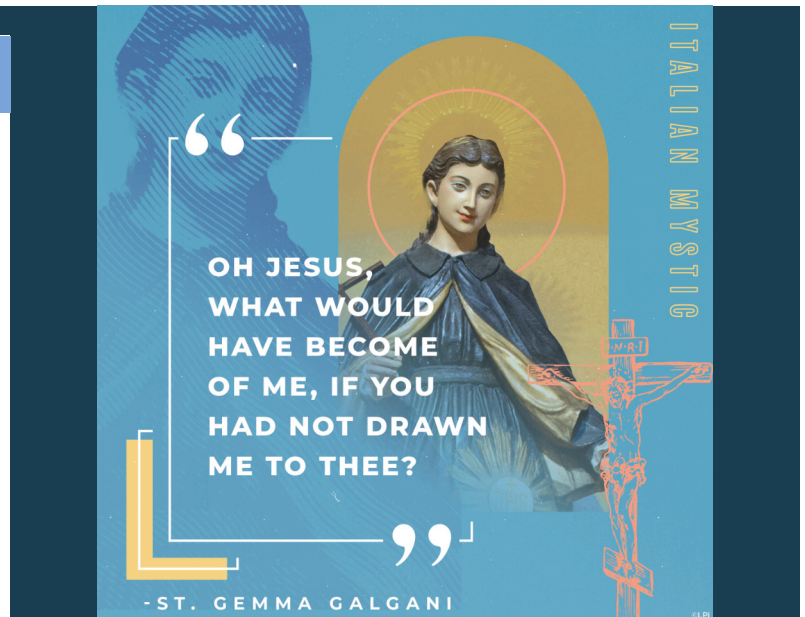
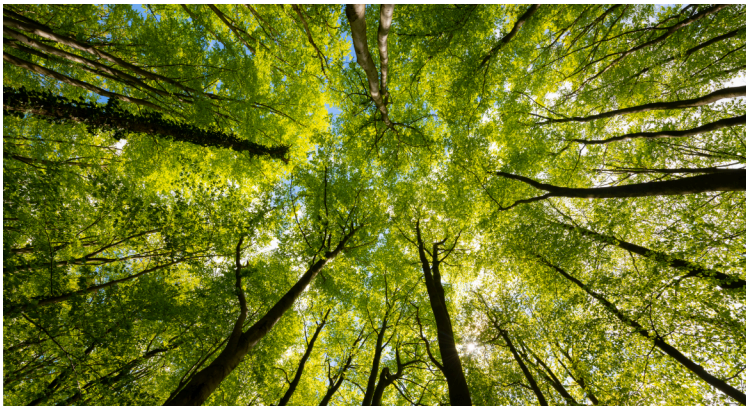

Poem of the Month

The Mercy of God by Jessica Powers

I am copying down in a book from my heart's
archives
the day that I ceased to fear God with a shadowy
fear.
Would you name it the day that I measured my
column of virtue
and sighted through windows of merit a crown that
was near?
Ah, no, it was rather the day I began to see truly
that I came forth from nothing and ever toward
nothingness tend,
that the works of my hands are a foolishness
wrought in the presence
of the worthiest king in a kingdom that shall never
end.
I rose up from the acres of self that I tended with
passion
and defended with flurries of pride;
I walked out of myself and went into the woods of
God's mercy,
and here I abide.
There is greenness and calmness and coolness, a
soft leafy covering
from the judgment of sun overhead,
and the hush of His peace, and the moss of His
mercy to tread.
I have naught but my will seeking God; even love
burning in me
is a fragment of infinite loving and never my own.
And I fear God no more; I go forward to wander
forever
in a wilderness made of His infinite mercy alone.



St. Gemma Galgani (1878-1903) was born in Camigliano, Tuscany. Her mother, a devout woman, helped Gemma prepare for her Confirmation at 8 years old. Unfortunately, at the Mass celebrating her Confirmation, Gemma was called to give up her mother who died of tuberculosis not long after. The next year, Gemma wished to make her First Communion, because she was only 9, she was granted special permission to do so. After her mother's death, Gemma was educated by Sisters of St. Zita at a day school.

In 1897, Gemma's father died, leaving his children destitute. Taken in by relatives, the orphan fell seriously ill just one year later. She suffered a curvature of the spine, was paralyzed, and struck deaf. She had large abscesses on her head and her hair fell off. On her deathbed, she received a vision of St. Gabriel of the Sorrowful Mother who promised to pray a novena to the Sacred Heart with her. Miraculously, when the novena ended, she was cured.

Despite her recovery, she was still unable to obtain permission to enter a Passionist order as she desired because of the fragility of her health. Gemma nonetheless continued to live an intense prayer life. She experienced ecstasies and was even reported to levitate. 1899, at the age of 21, Gemma received the grace of the holy stigmata. Each Thursday evening, the marks of the wounds of Christ would appear, disappearing on Friday or Saturday. She is called the "Daughter of the Passion" because of her deep union with Christ's Passion.

In January 1903, Gemma contracted tuberculosis. She suffered greatly and eventually died in April of that year, on Holy Saturday. She was beatified in 1933 by Pope Pius XI and canonized in 1940 by Pope Pius XII. St. Gemma Galgani, pray for us!

BASE TUITION

At St. Peter the Apostle Catholic School, students receive a Catholic classical education rooted in the liberal arts tradition and anchored in our Catholic faith.

Every tuition dollar supports not only high-quality instruction but also a vibrant community centered on faith, virtue, and service.

Our students have the privilege of attending Mass and faith formation programs including sacramental preparation.

REQUIRED FEES

This fee covers costs incurred immediately upon enrollment and is required to reserve your student's spot for the upcoming year.

ADDITIONAL FEES

Fees associated with field trips and other incidentals are not included and may be assessed periodically.

PAYMENT PLAN OPTIONS

Payment plans are estimated off of base tuition and do not reflect sibling rates or additional charges.

BASE TUITION **\$10,900** → **12 MONTH \$908 per month** **11 MONTH \$990 per month** **10 MONTH \$1,090 per month**

12-month tuition plans begin in June 2026, 11-month in July, and 10-month in August. Textbooks and curriculum materials are included in the price of tuition. School supplies, after-school care, extracurricular activities, and uniforms are *not* included.

You, our current families, are our best recruiters, as many inquiring families initially hear about St. Peter the Apostle Catholic School from our current families. As we begin our application and enrollment processes for the 2026-2027 school year, we want to reward you for promoting our school among your family and friends. How does it work? Refer a family to St. Peter the Apostle Catholic School. If they enroll, receive a **\$1,000 tuition credit** as our way of saying thank you for helping us spread the word about the success, excellence, and traditions of SPTA!

Program Details:

- The tuition credit will be applied to the referring family's FACTS Tuition Account in January 2027 after the newly enrolled family has completed the first half of the year and is continuing enrollment in January.
- Current families may refer multiple families and receive \$1,000 tuition credit per family who enrolls.
- The tuition credit is \$1,000 *per family* regardless of the number of students enrolled by that family.
- The referring family must have a student enrolled at SPTA at time of payment (January 2027) to be eligible to receive the tuition credit through FACTS.
- Referred families must be new to the school (children cannot have been enrolled at SPTA previously).

Process:

- The new family must include referring family's name on the FACTS enrollment form.
- The referring family will be notified of the new family's enrollment and eligibility for referral tuition credit once the new family has been accepted and completed the enrollment process.
