Being of Scottish background, Ursan indicated the Scots are impervious to and revel in stereotype and cliché. The score is tuneful and old fashioned. Some of the plot points have changed where they occurred in the original J. M. Barrie play and some have just been gotten rid of entirely. The Darling Family, Nana the Nursemaid/Dog, Peter, Hook, Tink and the Pirates still people the stage - all using dialogue from the original with additions from Robert's sensibilities.



It takes the courage and tenacity of Hansel & Gretel, along with a group of misfit friends, to save the day and set things right.



Filmed entirely in Niagara and performed by Teens from the Niagara, Stratford and Toronto areas.


