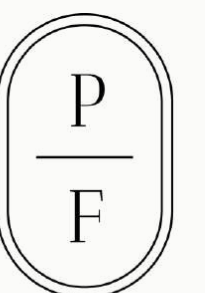

Lake Como, Italy

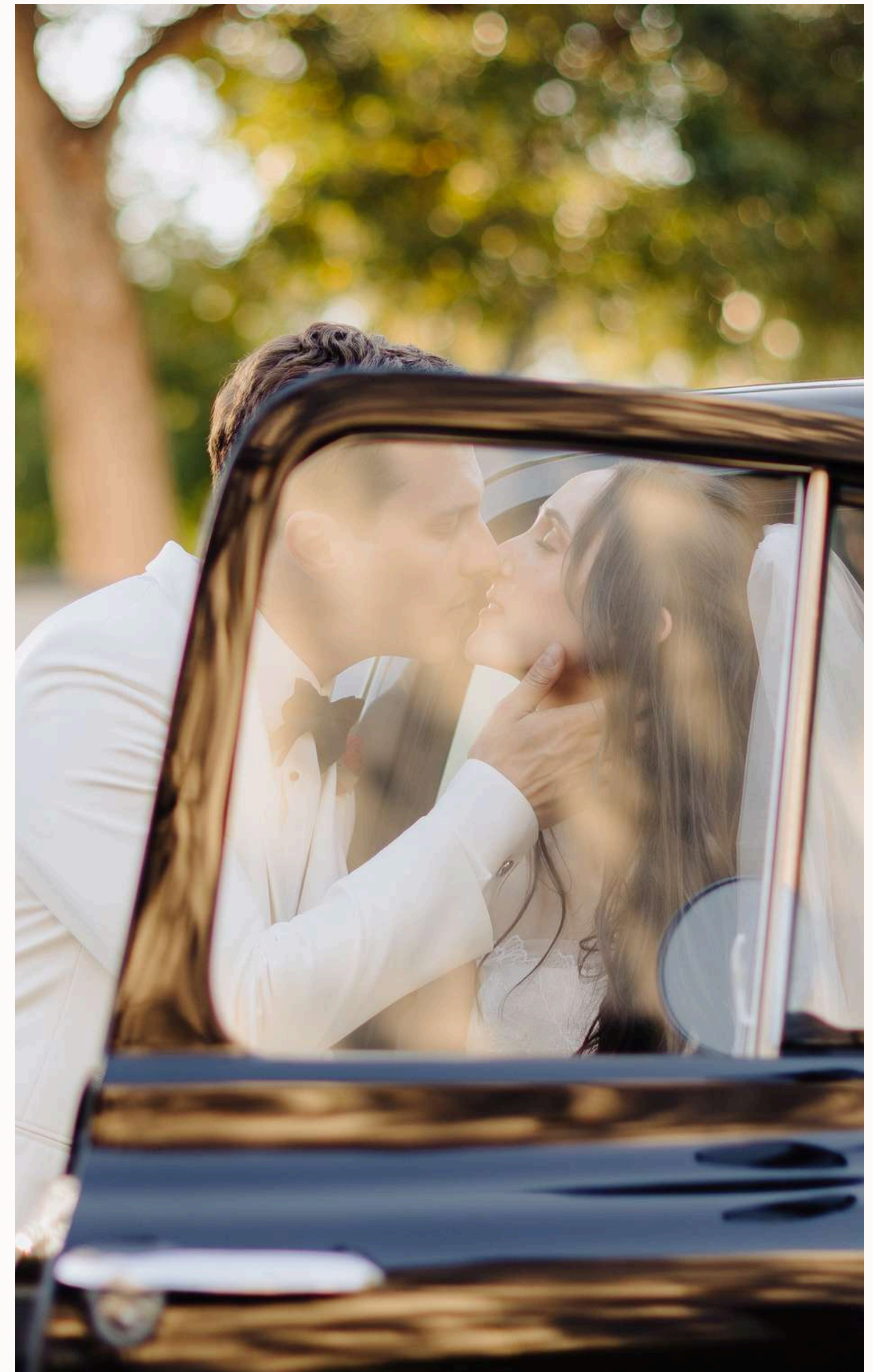
Perfect for couples who want high-end elegance, world-class Italian cuisine, and dramatic alpine scenery.

It appeals to the adventurous soul who wants architectural drama, vibrant spice markets, and a wedding that feels like a journey to another world.

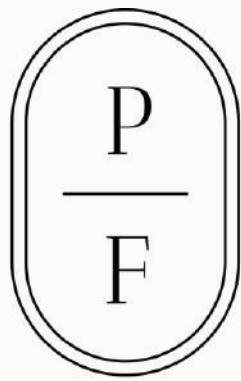


Algarve, Portugal
