That's why I'm not a fly-on-the-wall photographer. Instead, I create opportunities for you to genuinely relax and connect through gentle guidance, good conversation, movement-based prompts and constant feedback.

You won't just be looking at the camera and smiling (unless that's what you want). Instead, we'll go for a walk and make space for you to sink into those gorgeous, loved-up vibes without feeling fake.

Most of all, I want you to have fun. This might be my job, but it's your moment. And I'm going to do everything I can to help you stay present in it.





ON YOUR WEDDING DAY

01/

I'll be there early, with a big smile, lots of batteries, back up cameras and good vibes. I'll introduce myself to everyone and make sure you feel calm and centred. I'll keep an eye on the timeline so you can stay present.

02/

When it comes to your ceremony, I take a documentary approach. I'll focus on you, your wedding party and your quest's reactions without interrupting the flow.

03/

As we switch to group shots, I'll use my 'outside voice' to herd guests with military precision. I'll encourage natural interactions and laughter so you don't all look like deers in headlights. I know everyone will be keen to party so I try to make this as quick and hilarious as possible.

04/

Your portrait session is a break from the rush of the day - a chance to slow down, soak it in and reconnect. We can get it done in 15 minutes or take our time to get even more variety of wedding photos.

05/

During your reception, I'll aim to capture those unposed moments of laughter, joy and silliness – your baby cousin eyeing off the cake, your best mates belting out Pink Pony Club on the dancefloor, and you two sharing a cheeky snog when you think no-one is looking.

all Heart, No awkwardness

If the idea of having a photographer third-wheeling all day makes you nervous, I get it. Cameras are intimidating and suddenly you can't remember how to stand normally or what to do with your hands.

My party trick is knowing how to snap you out of that feeling – whether that's through jokes and laughter, deep conversation, quick breaks or gentle direction.

So you can spend less time worrying about the camera, and more time soaking up those 'just married' feelings.



FLIGHT PACKAGE (2.5 HOURS)

Best for elopments or very intimate ceremonies. The one to choose when you only need coverage for your ceremony and some epic lover's portraits afterwards. During peak season, this is available Monday to Friday only.

Phone and email support, including vendor recommendations

Portrait location scouting

Coverage for 2.5 hours

High-resolution images delivered via a private online gallery and print shop

80kms wedding day travel

A sneak peek of a handful of images within 3 business days

Complete gallery delivered within 4 weeks

Total Cost: \$1,600



LIGHT PACKAGE (4 HOURS)

The one to choose when you just want the ceremony, group photos, couple's portraits and the start of the reception captured.

Inclusions:

Phone and email support, including vendor recommendations

Portrait location scouting

Coverage for 4 hours

High-resolution images delivered via a private online gallery and print shop

80kms wedding day travel

A sneak peek of a handful of images within 3 business days

Complete gallery delivered within 6 weeks

Total Cost: \$2,000





BRIGHT PACKAGE (6 HOURS)

Generally, this allows me to capture most of the day and then leave after speeches. Depending on your locations, this could also include getting ready imagery for one or both of you.

Inclusions:

Phone and email support, including vendor recommendations

Portrait location scouting

Coverage for 6 hours

High-resolution images delivered via a private online gallery and print shop

80kms wedding day travel

A sneak peek of a handful of images within 3 business days

Complete gallery delivered within 6 weeks

Total Cost: \$2,900





NIGHT PACKAGE (8 HOURS)

The one to choose when you both want your getting ready moments captured, as well as ceremony, family, wedding party and couple's portraits, and most of the reception. I'll usually leave after your first dance.

Inclusions:

Phone and email support, including vendor recommendations

Portrait location scouting

Coverage for 8 hours

High-resolution images delivered via a private online gallery and print shop

80kms wedding day travel

A sneak peek of a handful of images within 3 business days

Complete gallery delivered within 6 weeks

+ Complimentary engagement session (and 25 kms travel for this shoot)

Total Cost: \$3,800

FREQUENTLY asked QUESTIONS

How many images can I expect?	For small weddings or elopements, around 50-70 per hour of coverage. For large weddings, around 80-100 per hour.
Why should I do an engagement shoot?	Engagement shoots are a low-pressure, relaxed trial run for your wedding day. They give us a chance to really get to know each other, talk about the portrait process, discover your best poses, and alleviate any nerves about having your photo taken. This helps your wedding day run more smoothly as you are ready to confidently rock your portraits! There's no pressure of guests or a timeline.
How much coverage time will I need?	It really depends how much you have planned for your day and how close your preparation, ceremony, portrait and reception spots are to each other. Most couples will only need 8 hours of coverage for getting ready, ceremony, portraits and the first half of the reception.
Can you help me plan the timeline?	Absolutely! We'll get together before your big day to chat about everything and put together a rock-solid plan with plenty of time to spare.
When is the best time for photos?	Hands down the best time of day for photos is the hour before sunset. We call this 'the golden hour' and it usually offers flattering soft light. I'll always recommend trying to do your portraits at this time, but if it's not possible, don't worry! I know plenty of tricks to get the most out of any light situation.
Can you help me pick a portrait location?	Absolutely! If your wedding is within an hour's drive of Coffs Harbour, I'll scout nearby locations before your big day so we know exactly where to go after the ceremony. I grew up on the Mid North Coast so I know plenty of epic secret spots.
My ceremony and reception are at different times. Can you split your coverage?	My packages are for continuous coverage only. However, if your ceremony and reception are at different times, there's plenty we can do to keep busy during those hours, including family photos and couple's portraits, details shots of the

invitations and rings, photos of the venue and decorations,

and of course, take a required meal break.
