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Budget

DISCUSS THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:

How much can we realistically and comfortably afford to spend on the wedding?

Based on our monthly income, how much can we reasonably save between now and the wedding?

How much, if any, can we responsibly pull from an existing savings account?

Are there any other key players that will be contributing financially to our wedding?

Make sure to meet with any contributors promptly to discuss the details.

Will these key players be adding to the guest list as well?

Who will be ultimately responsible for financial / budgeting decisions?

TO DO FOR YOU:

- Review average wedding costs in your area to help set realistic expectations of what type of wedding you can afford.
- Build an Emergency Fund / Unexpected Costs buffer of at least 5% into your overall wedding budget. *(Search "Hidden Wedding Costs" on the Here Comes The Guide website for a comprehensive list.)*
- Get EVERYTHING in writing. Before you sign the dotted line on any venue or vendor contract, make sure you know exactly what's included in your package—and what's not.
- DON'T go into debt to say I Do. If you do use credit, pay off the balance as soon as possible. Look beyond the "big day" to your "big life"!
