# GENERAL INFORMATION

## Attire & Equipment

- Riding boots with a heel and an ASTM approved riding helmet are mandatory for all riders.
- Formal Show attire is encouraged for all classes
- USEF rules will be followed for horse equipment. Exception: Wraps or boots are allowed.
- Martingales are prohibited in non-jumping and hunter hack classes

## Dangerous Riding

If show management and/or judges see dangerous riding, 1 warning will be issued. Second occurance will be dismissed from show arena.

#### Classes

- USHJA membership is NOT required to show.
- Riders and trainers must be a USHJA member (Outreach level, which is free, or higher) BEFORE the show in order for points to count for the USHJA Outreach year-end awards. Riders collect points to redeem at year end for items of their choice such as USHJA logo wear, ribbons, or medallions. - Show management reserves the right to refuse any entries at its sole discretion.
- Show management reserves the right to combine classes/divisions or cancel classes if necessary and/or in the interest of time.
- Classes with age restrictions will be based on the age of the rider as of Dec. 1, 2024.
- Exhibitors are expected to be prompt for their classes. A two minute call will be placed on an open gate.
- For the welfare of all horses competing and at the recommendation of USEF judges, the suggested maximum number of classes over fences is 4 and not more than 6 per horse per day will be permitted.
- Trainers are asked to enter as an unjudged round.
- After 3 refusals, riders will be excused from the arena

#### Awards

- Prizes have been graciously sponsored by Kahoots in San Tan Valley and Greenway Saddlery in Scottsdale.
- Ribbons 1st-6th will be awarded in all classes with special prizes for 1st place
- High Point Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in all divisions with 3 or more riders. Riders must show & be judged in the entire division to be awarded Champion or Reserve Champion

#### Stalls

- Limited quantity of stalls are available the day of the show on a first come first served basis.
- Reservations for stalls must be made and paid for in advance
- Stalls are temporary pens
- All stalls include 1 bag of shavings. Additional shavings are \$12 per bag. You may bring your own shavings if you prefer. You will need to supply your own water buckets.

#### Schooling

- Schooling in the show arena will be open for a maximum of 15 minutes before each division. All horses in the schooling/warm-up arena MUST have a show number attached to the horse or the rider/handler. Any horse without its correct number will be asked to leave the arena.
- Riders may only enter arena schooling before the division they are showing in.
- A warm-up arena with fences will be available during the duration of show
- A lunging arena will be available on a first come first served basis.
- LUNGING IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE SAME AREA IN WHICH HORSES ARE BEING RIDDEN.

\$20 Haul in fee per horse (waived with stall reservation) \$40 Day stall (Bring your own shavings or purchase during preregistration)\*

\$12 Bag of shavings

\$22 Entry fee per class - day of show

\$18 Pre-entry fee per class (Must be received by midnight 10/5/25)

\$45 Pre-entry for 3 class Hunter division (must be received by midnight on 10/5/25)

\$75 Pre-entry for 5 class Hunter division (must register for the whole division and be received by midnight 10/5/25)

\$30 Pre-entry for 2 class Jumper Division (must register for both classes and be received by midnight 10/5/25)

All credit card transactions will be subject to a 3% convenience fee

\*All horses must pay either a haul-in fee or a stall fee, not both. Stalls are not required.

## Payment Method

- Cash, check, or debit/credit card
- There will be a 3% credit/debit convenience fee added to all transactions
- There will be a \$50 returned check fee

#### Miscellaneous

- No Smoking in or near the warm-up arena, show arena, or in or near any building!
- No Alcohol the possession or consumption of alcohol is not allowed
- All dogs must be on a leash.
