The ceremony can take place inside the Jubilee Hall or in good weather on the main lawn.

Prices quoted in the enclosed rate card include VAT and vary depending on day of the week and month of the year.

We include a 12m marquee on the main lawn for shade or shelter during the afternoon reception, along with deckchairs & garden games. The day takes place inside so that your guests stay warm and dry with access to the gardens for photographs.

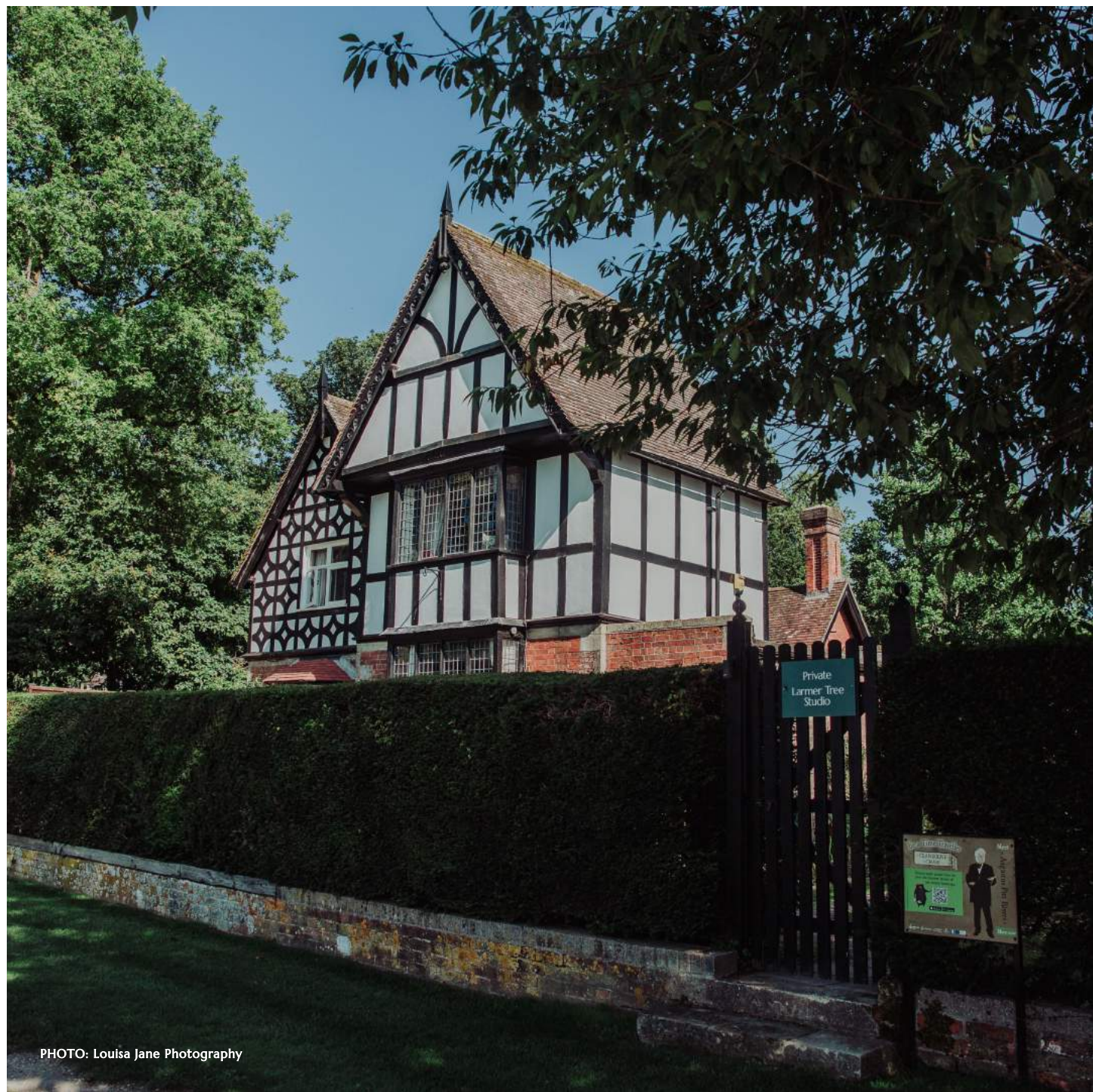

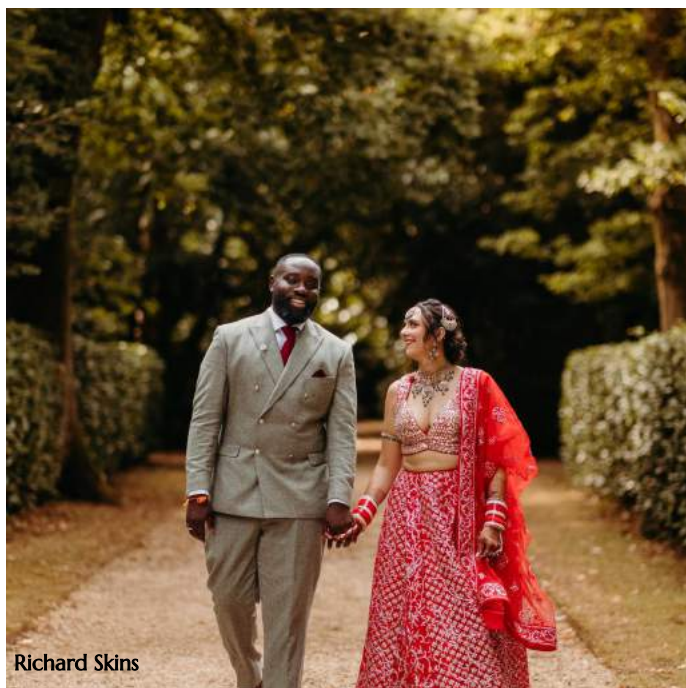
# Larmer Tree Studio

# Frequently Asked Questions

**CANDLES** We provide tea lights on the dining tables should you wish, however if you would like taller church candles, they need to be housed within a hurricane lamp, or similar, to prevent the risk of fire and wax damage.

**CHILDREN** are very welcome at Larmer Tree, however there are ponds and other potential hazards, within the grounds, so it is important that children are accompanied if they wish to explore.

**CONFETTI** Of course! Your guests are welcome to throw confetti but please, be kind to our peacocks and use fresh or dried petals or other natural confetti.

**CORKAGE** If you would rather supply your own choice of wine during dinner, there will be a small charge to cover chilling, glassware, service and washing up!

**CURFEW** All good things come to an end and finish times will depend on the day and month of your celebration. The bar will close 15 minutes earlier to allow time for guests to finish their drinks.

**DECORATION** Every wedding is unique and we encourage your personal decoration. If there is no event the day prior, you're very welcome to decorate yourselves or if this is not possible, hand them over and we can arrange.

**FIREWORKS** For safety reasons, displays must be organised by a competent pyrotechnic with the appropriate insurance cover. Sadly fireworks are not permitted during lambing season (April—May)

**FURNITURE** In the dining room we can offer round or long dining tables & wooden crossback chairs are included in the venue cost.

**LIVE MUSIC** Yes Please! During your ceremony, on the Singing Theatre, overlooking the lawn, and in the Jubilee Hall for the evening party. There really is nothing better to ignite the party.

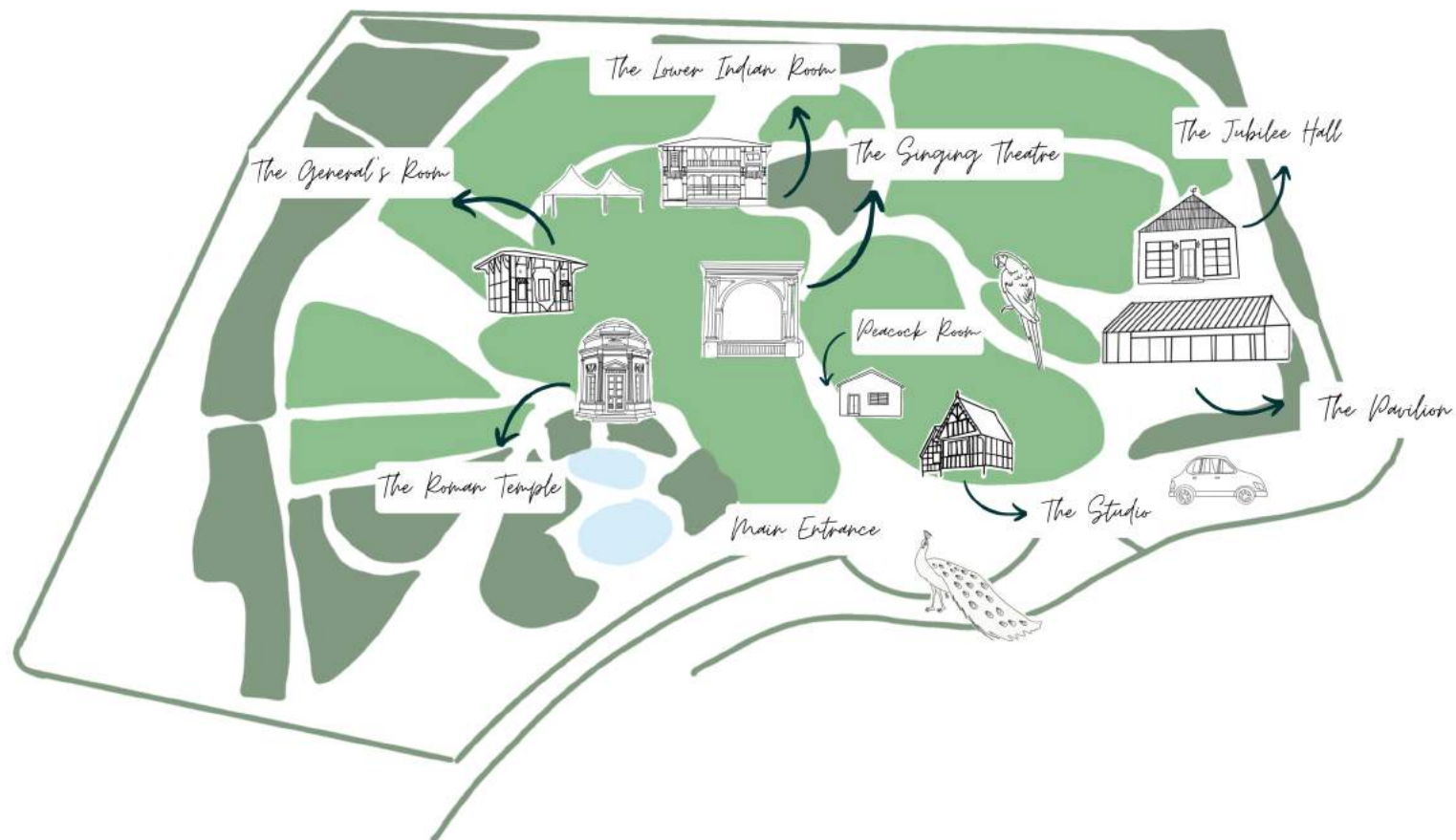
**MAXIMUM CAPACITY** Our dining room is 15m x 7.5m and can seat a maximum of 150 guests. During the evening reception, we can accommodate up to 250 guests.

**PHOTO OPPORTUNITIES** Are endless! It's always a good idea to meet your photographer prior to the big day and go through the chosen photography locations.

**REGISTRARS** For a marriage ceremony on site, you need to contact Wiltshire Registrars to conduct this for you. If you would prefer a blessing or something more personal we can recommend an independent celebrant or humanist.

**SUPPLIERS** We have a comprehensive recommended list of really amazing local suppliers. However, you are welcome to invite your own choice of florist, photographer, musicians etc and we will offer them as much assistance as possible. All food and drink is prepared and served by our catering partner, Forkingout Ltd.
