

Prior to coming to Florida in 1983, he served in planning and development positions for the cities of Greenwood and Columbia, SC. As a consultant and as a member of the cities' staff he was involved in the development and construction of commercial and institutional projects within the urban core of each city. For the last nine years in Florida, Mr. Pabalis has worked in a senior management capacity with America's largest design and construction companies CRSS and Turner Construction Company. In that capacity he was involved in design and construction contracts ranging in value from \$5 million to well over \$100 million. His experience includes hi-rise office buildings, hotels, hospitals, correctional facilities, airports, stadiums and theme parks. His design and construction contract experience includes program management, construction management, general contracting, architectural, civil and interior design. By virtue of his expereince he has served as an arbitrator for the AAA in over one hundred hearing days on construction and design cases involving domestic as well as international companies. The claims in these cases ranged from \$4,000 to \$10,000,000 in value. In addition, to his construction arbitration experience he serves as a securities arbitrator for the AAA and the NASD Board of Arbitrators in New York and is a Certified Mediator in Florida for family and county cases. Currently Mr. Pabalis is Vice President and Partner in Metropolitan Construction, Inc. and President of Florimarks International, Inc. Dear Mr. Pabalis:

On behalf of the Board of Examiners for the Foreign Service, I am pleased to inform you that your name has been added to the list of eligible hires of those General Services Officer awaiting appointment.

The Registrar's Office utilizes this list of eligible hires to offer conditional offers appointment to the Foreign Service. The names on the list of eligible hires are ranked ordered by specialist category. A candidate's rank is based on his/her performance in the various stages of the selection process. When placed on the list of eligible hires, your name appeared in the middle third of those eligible.

The list of eligible hires is a living document and candidates are constantly added and removed. Your actual position on the list of eligible hires, as well as the total number of names on the list of eligible hires will vary. Therefore, the Registrar's Office can only provide you with information regarding your approximate standing on the list of eligible hires.

A conditional offer of appointment is dependent on a variety of factors, including budgetary constraints, hiring needs, and your position on the list of eligible hires relative to other candidates on the eligible list of hires and register.

Once we have received authorization for hire of your specialist category, and if your name is reached on the list of eligible, you will be contacted by phone and a conditional offer of appointment will be extended to you. At that time, you will receive the security and medical forms for completion and return to this office.

Your name was placed on the list of eligible hires May 21, 2002. Your name will remain on the list for a period of 24 months. If, after 24 months, you have not been made a conditional offer of appointment, your name will be withdrawn from the list of eligible hires, and you will have to start the selection process over if you still wish to join the Foreign Service

Conditional offers of appointment are made on short notice, and candidates may be given only a few days to respond to an offer. Therefore, the Registrar's Office urges you to consider in advance whether you intend to join the Foreign Service if you receive a conditional offer of appointment.

You should notify the Registrar's Office in writing of any change of address or telephone number. You should also inform the Registrar's Office of changes in your marital, family, or employment status. Please submit any changes of information to the address presented below:























































161 Cortland Ave. Winter Park Proposed Design
