

Our address: 2626 Nagymaros, Pállya Celesztin street plot no. 10783/8. We will welcome you upon arrival.

Getting here, check-in, check-out, basic information

- 

We recommend using the Google Maps application to get to the accommodation; we do not recommend the WAZE application, as it often tries to take you via the ferry, which is not the shortest route, especially when coming from Budapest! Please enter 'Pállya Celesztin street' into the application. The house is located at the very end of the street; after the paved road, a short dirt road follows, then you can drive over a small bridge, from which another paved road leads up a steep incline to the house.

- 

Arrival: Check-in is possible from 2 PM. (For earlier check-in, please notify us of the time via email). Upon your arrival at the house, you will receive the key, and we will give you a guided tour of Grand Maros.

- 

Departure: Please vacate the house by 11 AM on the day of departure. If you wish to arrive earlier or stay longer, please inform us in advance, and we will do our best to accommodate.

- 

Parking is possible for 1 car in the driveway; additional cars can be parked in front of the gate, free of charge.

- 

The house includes a small lake suitable for refreshing, an organic garden, a fireplace, a swimming pool, and a sports field (see below for their use).

The accommodation price includes

The use of the two levels of the house and the garden enclosed by an electric fence.

- 

The use of the equipment in the house and the tools necessary for their use.

- 

Hot water and the cooling system. On summer days, an air conditioning system helps tolerate the heat; please use the air conditioner with closed windows, and if possible, when someone is in the room. Green, environmentally conscious thinking is part of Kövesliget's philosophy; we strive to use energy wisely, as we also believe that sustainable development is unimaginable without it. Our request regarding towel usage is similar: If possible, do not throw it on the floor after one use. Please use as little plastic as possible. We collect plastic and other waste selectively.

- 

For water consumption, we recommend the purified water available in the house (served by the small tap in the corner of the sink area).

- 

Grand Maros is surrounded by forests, so insects live around the house and in the garden. Their quantity varies by season and period; in summer, you may frequently encounter wasps, hornets, bees, bumblebees, and mosquitoes. The best defense is to keep the mosquito nets (which we

have installed on most windows and patio doors) drawn, and to wear slippers or shoes in the garden. If you notice the presence of insects in the house, please do not hesitate to contact us.

#### Payment methods

The tourist tax (580 Ft/person/night, for those over 18) is already included in the price when booking.

#### Cancellation policy

- 

The house can be booked for a minimum of 2 nights.

- 

In case of cancellation, the amount will be refunded under the following conditions: If you have to cancel your trip, we cannot refund the deposit, but it can be freely used for another chosen date.

#### House amenities, information

- 

The house has 2 levels. On the lower level, there is a washbasin with a toilet, an accessible bathroom, the American kitchen, a large living room, and a guest room for 3 people with its own bathroom. On the upper level, there are 3 separate bedrooms with their own shower and toilet, one of which has an infrared sauna, and 3 other rooms which share a bathroom with a bathtub, toilet, and washbasin. Of the 6 rooms upstairs, 3 have French beds (2 of which are 140 cm wide), and 3 rooms can be arranged with twin beds.

- 

WiFi is free in the house, the password is Kilatas123, which belongs to the Kövesmező username.

- 

Washing machine use is available upon request.

- 

The kitchen is equipped with the following appliances: dishwasher (capsules are located under the sink), refrigerator, freezer, electric hob, oven, microwave oven, toaster. In addition, cutlery, wine glasses, mugs, coffee glasses and cups, water glasses, bowls, plates, as well as pots, pans, glasses, plates, and cutlery needed for cooking are all available. The kitchen also has an automatic coffee machine with coffee. Furthermore, various teas, brown sugar, honey, salt, spices, as well as clean kitchen towels and paper towels are provided.

- 

Feel free to use the non-perishable food items from the pantry: oil, flour, etc.

- 

Waste collection is selective; under the sink, you will find the communal and selective bins, into which clean (!) plastic, paper, and metal are collected. Compost, i.e., organic waste, and 'green feed' for chickens are also collected separately in the kitchen storage.

- 

The donkeys can not only be observed from the height of the sign indicating them, but if you let us know, you can also interact with them.

- 

Bathroom and bedroom amenities: Our guests are provided with clean bed linen, hand towels, bath mats, towels, and pool towels. Blankets are also provided on the beds and on the sofa. In

the bathrooms, liquid soap, cotton pads, cotton swabs, shampoo, hair conditioner, body lotion, and a hairdryer are provided. Tissues are located on the small cabinet in the dining area.

- 

The living room has two large sofas. Numerous books are available on the living room bookshelf; those marked as 'take-away' books can be chosen freely.

- 

Board games (chess board, Scrabble, Activity, etc.) are freely available for use as desired.

- 

For guests arriving with child(ren): high chair, baby cot are provided upon request; baby dinnerware can be found in the kitchen. Numerous children's toys and books are available for the little ones in the living room! Parents are strongly requested to keep children away from houseplants and to minimize any damage to them, if possible.

- 

For guests arriving with dogs: The house is dog-friendly. Max. number of dogs: 3. Please notify us of their arrival in advance so we can prepare amenities (towel, water and food bowls, dog waste bags). We kindly ask that dogs do not enter the pool and only sleep in their own beds; please ensure they enter the house clean, and use the blankets/throws we provide for them on the sofas (if necessary); dispose of collected waste properly wrapped in the bin in front of the small wooden house.

- 

Smoking is allowed on the terrace; an ashtray has been provided for this purpose.

- 

We take care of our plants and garden, including our organic garden, but you can also participate by assisting our garden care specialists.

- 

In case of watering, lawn mowing, or any other work that may involve even minimal noise, we will coordinate with our guests in advance!

- 

When outdoors, please respect the tranquility of the forest and our surroundings. Although there are no immediate neighbors, noises can carry down to the town. Therefore, please refrain from making loud noises before 8:00 AM and after 10:00 PM. Thank you!

- 

The garden includes a sun terrace and the pool with sun loungers. The sauna is located next to the pool.

- 

The sports field: please ensure that the sand stays within the court and that the court is used as intended. Of course, any sport or game is welcome.

- 

The treehouse, our 'zendo,' is a place for retreat, reading, and meditation. Please treat it as such.

- 

Our staff will sometimes be present to perform essential garden work or prepare breakfast for you. If they are not present and heavy rain is expected, we would be very grateful if you could bring the cushions indoors to the covered areas.

## Services

- 

Shopping options: there is a CBA supermarket in town, as well as a greengrocer, and several other small shops.

- 

Honesty Box: We often provide delicious local wines, as well as our homemade jams, syrups, herbal tea blends, biscuits, and cakes. The honesty box also serves in case something accidentally breaks or becomes unusable, despite your best attention and care. In such cases, we kindly ask for your support so that a new item can be made available to the next guests as soon as possible.

- 

Use the pool at your own risk. The pool is 130 cm deep, so children should only be allowed near the pool with supervision.

- 

Use the sauna at your own risk. The use of the garden sauna is possible by prior arrangement; please entrust its operation to the caretaker.

## Cleaning

We provide bathroom cleaning once daily in the house, with bed linen and towel change once a week. In addition, we can provide hotel-style cleaning (bed making, kitchen cleaning, keeping rooms tidy, preparation for cooking/grilling upon request and tidying up after meals, for 5 hours daily) to ensure a truly relaxing experience. The price for this is 20,000 Hungarian Forints per day. Given that both the kitchen and the other rooms are very spacious, we definitely recommend this service for larger groups.

## Sights in the area

If you're looking for an excursion, we believe Visegrád, accessible by ferry, is a must-see; its castle is visible from the garden, located directly opposite the house. For a forest hike, we recommend the blue route of the Börzsöny Mountains, which leads to the Julianus lookout tower, and from there, the hiking trail continues to the hermit caves. In addition, there are opportunities for rowing on the Danube. We are happy to assist you with any further questions or requests, hoping that you will feel at home during your stay here :)
