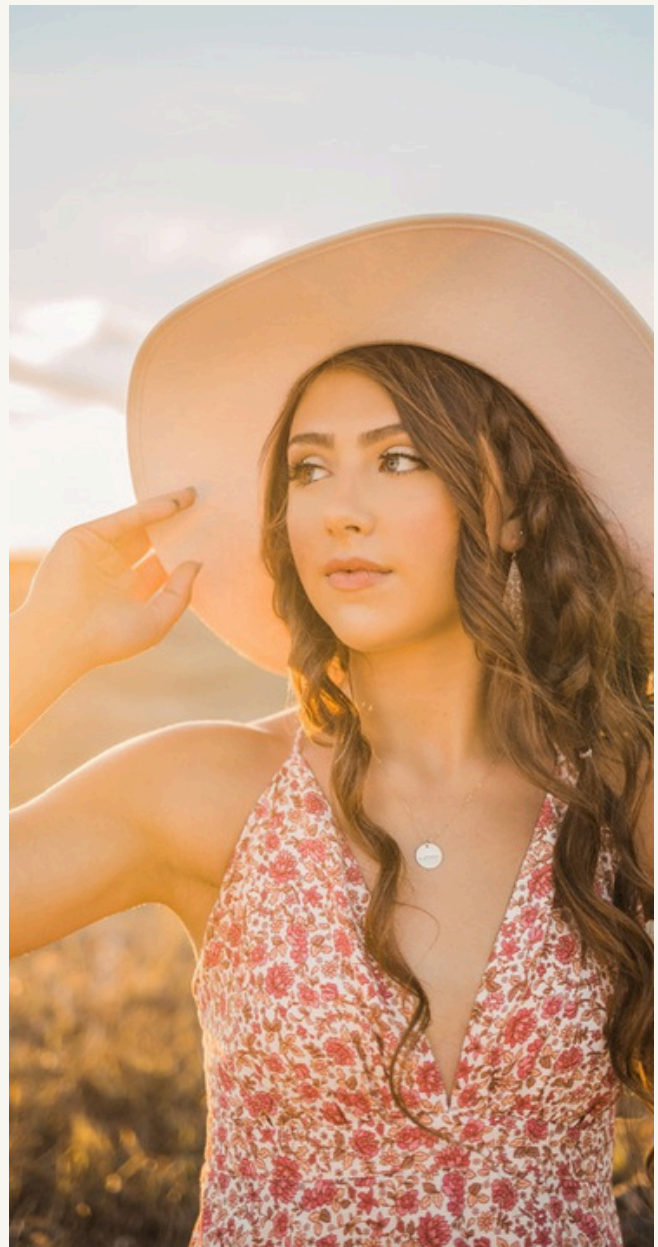

The Week Before Your Session

As your session day approaches, you can expect to hear from me about our meeting time and a final check-in. I usually wait until about a week before your session to confirm the exact time, as it depends on the locations we decide on. I only schedule sessions during the evening at "golden hour," which is typically 2-3 hours before sunset. This time of day offers the most beautiful, soft light and generally cooler temperatures—perfect for capturing those glowing, magical images!





SESSION DAY!

This section could easily be its own book—there’s so much to cover about what to expect on the day of your session! Below, I’ve outlined almost everything you can expect on the day of your senior session to help you feel fully prepared.

Being on Time

First things first: being on time is crucial. We’re working with the sun’s schedule, and trust me, the sun isn’t waiting for anyone!

Since we plan your session around the ideal time for golden lighting, being late means that you lose that time off of your session. Once the sun goes down, we can’t shoot anymore. If you are more than 30 minutes late for your session, we will have to reschedule.



Changing Outfits

I frequently get asked where my seniors will change outfits on their session day, and the answer is almost always in your car. The locations we shoot at rarely have public bathrooms, but I usually carry a pop up changing tent if you have an outfit that is difficult to put on in a vehicle.

TIP: It is helpful to bring along a parent or friend who is able to drive you to your locations during the session. That way you can change in the back while they are driving to save time!



Guided Posing

The most important thing to know about your portrait session is that I will be guiding and posing you the entire time. You don't need any posing or modeling experience—I'll be there every step of the way to make sure you feel comfortable and look your best!

Part of the investment in your senior portraits is my experience and ability to pose you and make you look and feel your absolute best. So, there's no reason to be nervous at all. I will guide you through every single pose and direct you to capture natural, effortless movement and laughter.

WHO TO BRING WITH YOU

Who will make you feel the most COMFORTABLE in front of the camera?

If you tend to be more shy and will feel awkward having your mom, dad, significant other or friend watching the entire time, we can ask them to wait in the car or just not attend at all. If you love having someone hype you up, bring them along!

However, we still need to keep your images as the top priority with minimal distractions. Bringing a large group of friends can sometimes be distracting while in front of the camera. This can mean you don't get as many great images or that time is taken away from the session. So, I request only bringing 1-2 people (1 parent + 1 friend). This ensures it won't take away from your focus during your session.





HAIR, MAKEUP + NAILS

The right hair and makeup can make all the difference in your portrait session and highly encourage you to hire professional hair and makeup to help you look and feel your absolute best on the day of your shoot.

Let's talk about why this is such a big game-changer for your experience:

TRAINED PROFESSIONALS

When you are investing in a professional photographer, you want to make sure that the images turn out the best they can. Professional hair and makeup artists are trained to do hair and makeup so that it photographs well, which will tremendously enhance your images.

LESS STRESS

I never want my seniors to feel like their session is just about “taking pictures”—I want it to be a true experience. When we start the session after you’ve been pampered and beautified for an hour, we’re already setting the tone for a fun and relaxed time! On the other hand, if you arrive feeling flustered or stressed from getting ready on your own, it can impact the entire experience, including how you look in the photos. Hiring out professional hair and makeup can help ensure you feel confident and ready to enjoy the session from the moment we begin!

Makeup

While your skin may be naturally flawless, the camera will bring out discoloration, dark circles and texture that you might not even notice on a normal day. Makeup artists use professional, highly effective foundations, pigments, powders and techniques that provide long lasting, flawless coverage while still appearing natural. Whether you are wanting a fresh natural look, or something smokey and dramatic, your makeup artist should help you feel absolutely beautiful the day of your portrait session.

TIP: Ask your makeup artist about a makeup trial! Makeup trials allow you to see how your makeup is going to look prior to your session and you will be able to ask for adjustments if desired. Talk with the makeup artist, show them photos of your inspiration and let them know the overall look that you're going for.

Hair

Hiring a professional stylist can truly elevate your final images. A stylist can help your hair look polished, hold up to wind or movement, and even adjust styles throughout your session if you'd like variety.

TIP: If you're planning multiple outfits, ask your stylist whether they can attend your session for touch-ups and additional hair changes. Switching up your hair between outfits adds fun variety and makes your gallery even more unique!

TIP: Ask your stylist about clip-in hair extensions if you're wanting added volume and length!

DON'T NEGLECT THE NAILS

In all of the chaos of senior session prep, don't forget to pamper your nails! During your session, some of the poses will have your hands close to your face and in the frame, so make sure to have a fresh manicure the day of your session. Subtle polish is usually best for portrait sessions. Bright colors can sometimes be distracting and if the color does not match all of your outfits it will clash. Be sure to do the same for toenails if you plan to wear open-toe shoes.

TIP: We suggest getting your nails done at a nail salon with gel polish. It is a hard polish that prevents your nails from chipping or breaking. If you want long natural nails the day of your session, start getting the gel polish a month or two in advance. You will need to get them done about every two to four weeks. This will give your nails time to grow.



LOCATIONS + LIGHTING

Aside from choosing your outfits (which we are diving into next, don't worry!) - choosing your LOCATIONS is a huge part of what will determine the overall style and aesthetic of your images. It also takes a little bit of logistical planning to map out where we will shoot and the travel time between locations. Overall, there are a few things to keep in mind when picking where to shoot:

It's actually not the location that matters most... it's the LIGHT!

Even if you have the most stunning garden location in mind with beautiful flowers and manicured pathways, it may not be ideal if it's in direct sunlight all day. The lighting plays a huge role in creating the best images. In fact, it might be better to shoot in a more unexpected spot, like a field by the side of the highway with gorgeous backlighting filtering through the trees. It's all about light—that's what truly makes the biggest difference in how your photos turn out!

That being said, I always scout my locations ahead of time. If you have a specific spot in mind for your session, please let me know a few weeks in advance. This gives me time to check it out and make sure it's the perfect fit for capturing the best possible images!

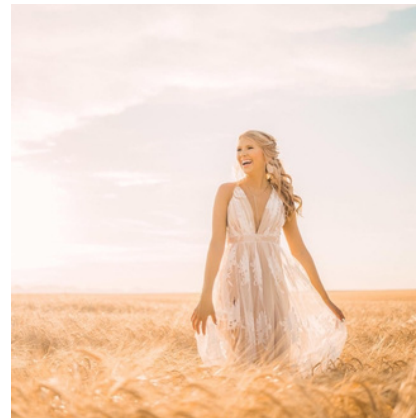
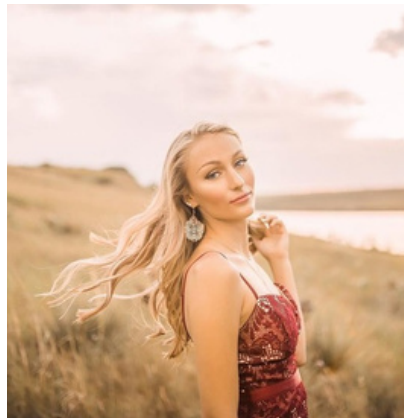
If you have NO IDEA where you want to go for locations, no problem, most of my seniors don't. Keep reading to browse potential location options, I know a lot of good ones!



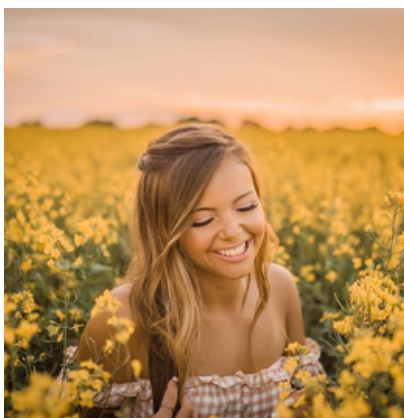

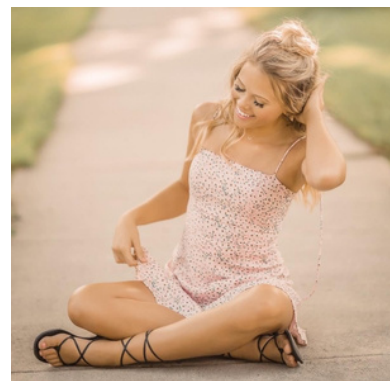
This is going to be an obvious choice for the seniors who booked a Glacier National Park Session, but there are some smaller mountains we can access while still staying around the Great Falls area.

WHAT TO WEAR

Choosing what to wear for your session is a huge decision and can be potentially stressful for some seniors. This section will break down my best tips for what to wear and how to style your senior session outfits.



BE COMFORTABLE, BE YOURSELF

When planning your outfits, remember this: if you don't feel comfortable or confident in what you're wearing, it will show in your photos. Choose something that makes you feel great, as that confidence will shine through in every shot!

Staying true to yourself with your outfits is important. When you look back at these images in 20+ years, you'll want them to truly reflect who you were in that moment. If you don't enjoy being girly and wearing frilly dresses, don't feel pressured to wear anything outside of your usual style. This entire session is meant to be about who YOU are in this exciting season of life, so don't change just for the photos!

USE A VARIETY OF COLORS

Use this session as an opportunity to have a little bit of fun with your outfits and colors! When choosing outfits for your senior session, try to choose colors that will compliment your locations and compliment your hair and skin tones. Also, make sure to mix up the colors of your outfits. Be careful not to do multiple outfits that are all the same color(s).



ADD LAYERS + ACCESSORIES

In the fall months, adding layers to your outfits can look beautiful and cozy in portraits. A sweater with a flannel underneath paired with a vest, statement earrings or scarf adds so much dimension to your images and makes for super fun posing options! Even in the summer months you can add layers and dimension using cute bralettes, statement earrings, jackets and hats!

PLAY WITH TEXTURES

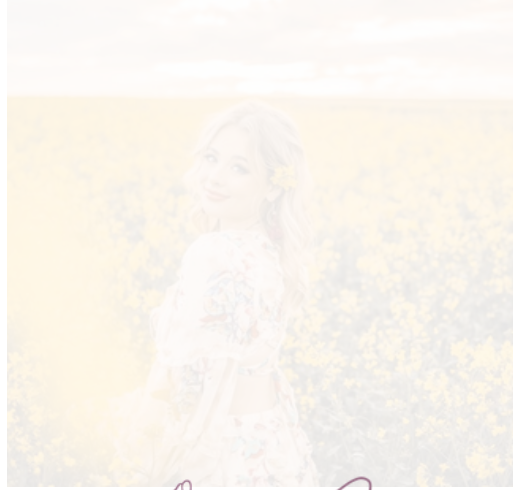
Sometimes textures like feathers, furs, and 3D florals might seem a bit extra, but in portraits, they can really make a statement! I also love incorporating pieces with movement—long, flowy dresses with dramatic trains, or fun ruffles and feathers that come to life when you twirl. It adds such a playful, dynamic element to your photos and makes them even more memorable!

MIX IT UP

When choosing your outfits, try to mix it up with a variety of styles. Think casual, dressy, sporty, school-related, preppy, edgy, or anything that represents you! I suggest picking 3-4 different styles and finding outfits for each. This will give you a wide range of looks during your session, ensuring you get a beautiful variety of portraits that truly capture all sides of your personality!

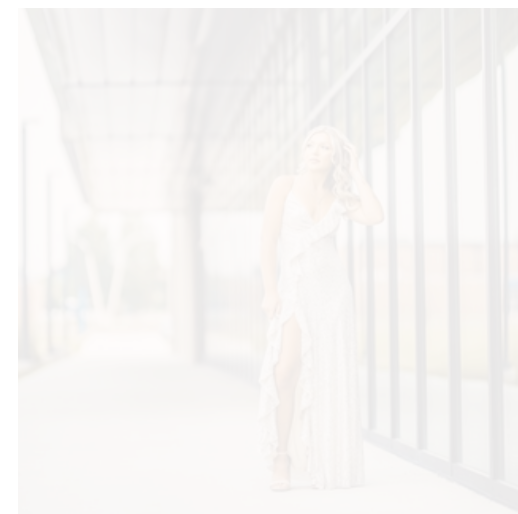
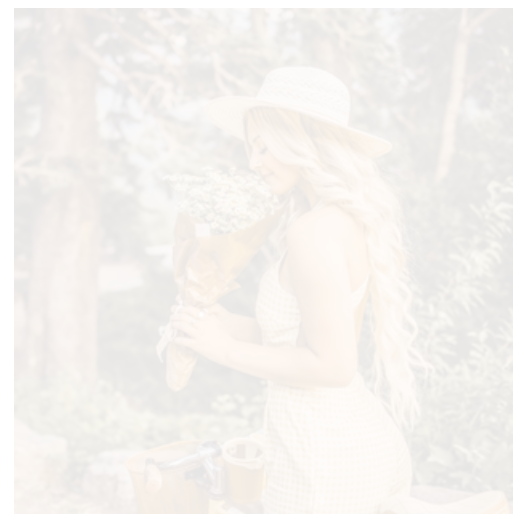
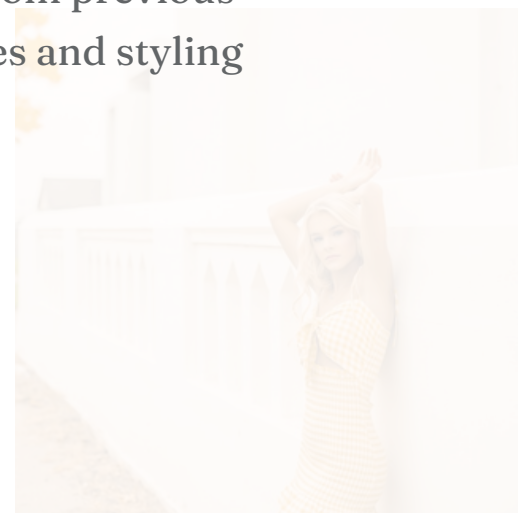
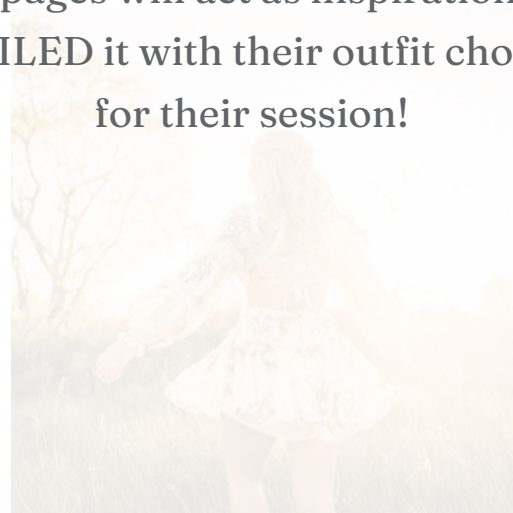
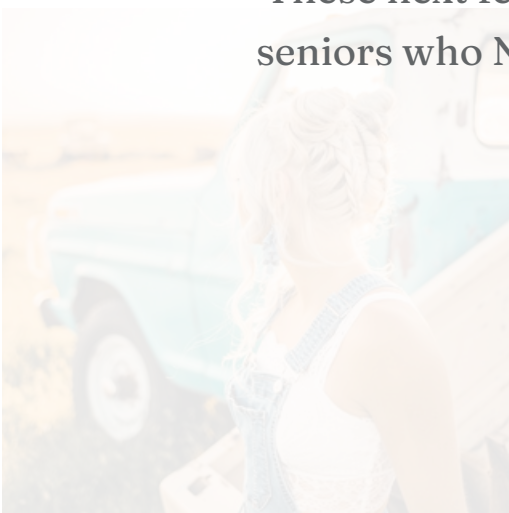
DON'T NEGLECT THE SHOES

I'll say it again—don't forget about the shoes! They can add so much personality and flair to your look. Shoes with a slight heel or arch can also help enhance the shape of your legs and improve your posture in photos. In addition to heels, I recommend having a different pair of shoes for each outfit to add even more variety to your session!

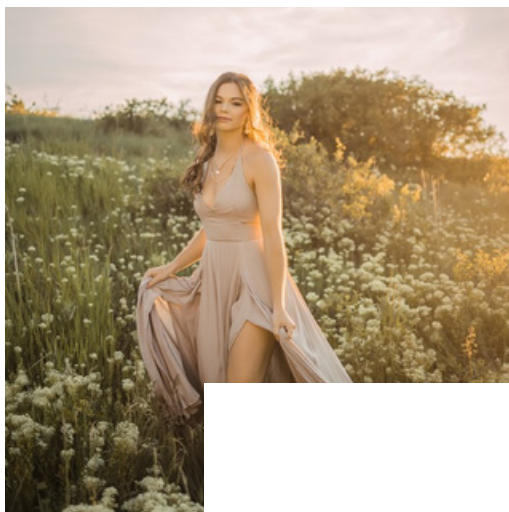




Morgan

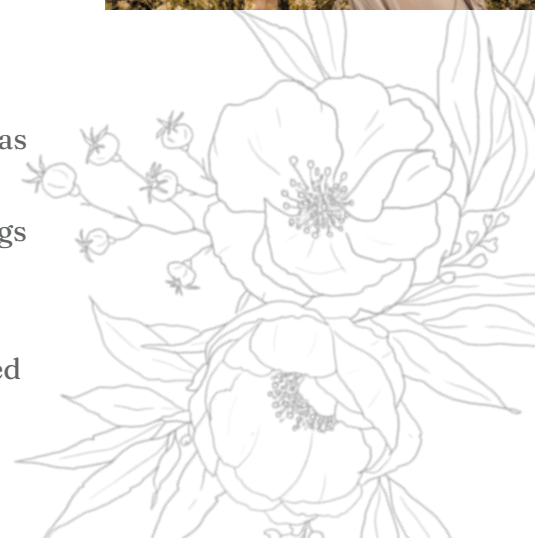

Taylor

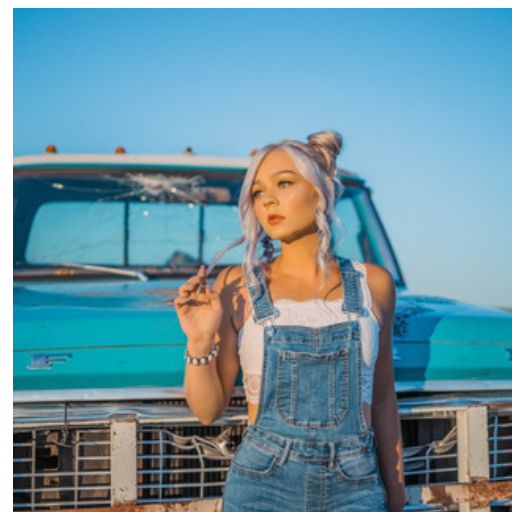

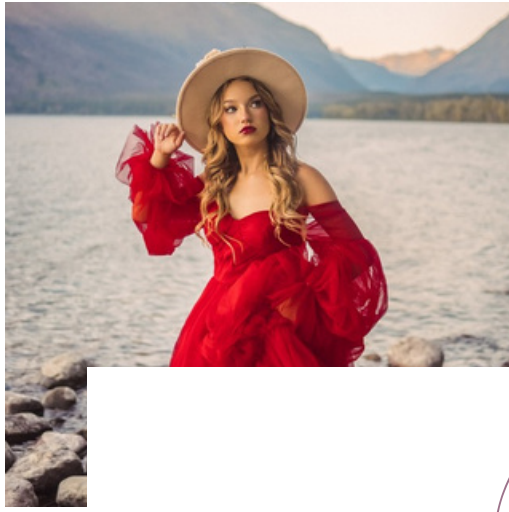

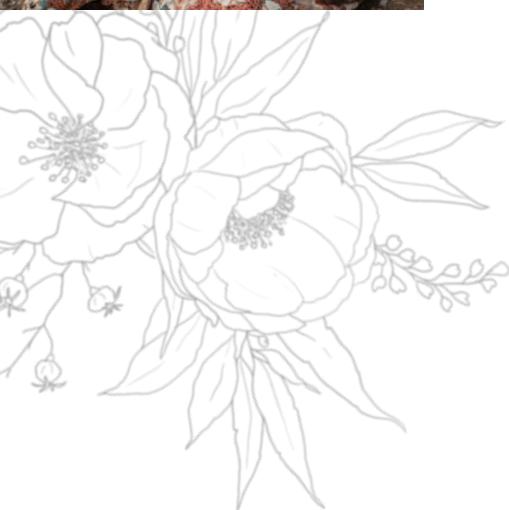


Chloe

Teigan wasn't afraid to be bold and unique with her outfits. Her flowy floral pants photographed beautifully. She paired her statement pants with a simple black top and added interest with her unique belt, statement earrings, rings, strappy black sandals and black hat.

THINGS TO AVOID

There are a few important things to avoid when planning your session, so let's dedicate a section to them! Here's a quick list of what to steer clear of to ensure your portraits turn out looking their best.

Pieces that are sheer, too fitted or potentially revealing

You will be doing a lot of moving throughout your shoot, so wearing pieces that have to sit juuuuust right or that are at risk of slipping aren't a good idea. And, if pieces are super thin or sheer, it may be see-through in your photos.

The wrong undergarments

This part is SO important! Be sure to bring along the CORRECT underwear, bras and/or adhesive covers for EACH outfit. There is nothing more distracting than a peeping bra strap or a bra that shows through your outfit. Also, please be cautious about sports bras. A lot of them are halter tops and the straps come up close to your neck, which can also show in your photos.

Pay attention to wrinkles

We will be doing a lot of moving around, sitting, walking, etc. at your session. If the material of your outfit easily wrinkles, you may want to rethink it. Pay close attention to textures and remember that not everything is as easy to edit out as you may think. Editing out wrinkles from a dress can be very time consuming, which can result in additional fees for extensive editing.





PLACES TO SHOP

Buying new clothes is not required for your senior session. Sometimes it can even be better to use clothes you already have that you know look good, but if you want to use your session as an excuse to shop a bit - some of my favorite shops are listed in your app under "Where to shop".

Fluffy Flowers

One of my FAVORITE ways to elevate any senior session is to add in some beautiful florals. To my girly girls, this one is for you! There are so many ways to incorporate flowers into your session. You can contact a local florist to put together something special, or buy some grocery store flowers to fill a purse, have a small bouquet as an extra detail or a floral installation at a location that you love. If you want to talk more about how to incorporate florals, reach out to me and I'm happy to help!



Fluffy Friends

If you have a pet that is a huge part of your life, feel free to bring them to your session! You'll be so glad you did when you look back at your images 10 years from now. Just make to let me know ahead of time so we can plan accordingly! A parent or friend will also need to come along to watch them for us when we aren't taking photos with them.



SPORTS + HOBBIES

Another way to customize your senior experience is to add in some of your favorite things that you do every day. I've had seniors want to highlight the sport they play, their favorite foods, their love for reading, shopping or their car... I've done it ALL! Use this section of the guide to start brainstorming ways we can creatively incorporate what makes you YOU!

Hobbies + Artists

As a photographer and artist, I love finding creative ways to highlight talent! If you paint, write, read, play an instrument or are a photographer yourself, let's show that off! We can find some really fun ways to highlight this, and I would love to have you bring along any pieces you are proud of to incorporate in your images!

Athletics + Sports

If you play a sport that you love and is a huge part of your high school career, let's highlight it! You can bring along your uniform, equipment, medals, poms, pointe shoes, etc... for some fun and creative photos.

Favorite Things

Incorporating your favorite things into your photos can be really creative, and also really fun! Are you someone who can't live without your daily Starbucks drink? Have a McDonald's fry obsession? In love with your car? Let's brainstorm together to find some fun ways to highlight these things at your session.



MINI SESSIONS

Why not make your senior year even more unforgettable by adding a mini session in addition to your regular senior session? You can choose from a bestie session, cap + gown session, college sweater session, or just a simple mini senior session. The mini senior session is especially popular because it lets you capture different looks throughout the year and across multiple seasons! Each mini session includes ten edited, high-resolution digital images with a print release.

Cap + Gown Mini Sessions

Because graduation gowns typically look a little like a potato sack (let's be honest), I typically photograph my seniors with them un-zipped to be a bit more flattering. I recommend wearing a sundress underneath - something white or neutral looks really traditional and timeless underneath the gowns. I also recommend a neutral pair of heels.

Don't forget to bring the tassel for the top of your cap, as well as any additional cords, awards or elements that you want to highlight. If you choose to decorate your cap, doing it before your shoot allows us to get the cutest detail photos of it!



Bestie Mini Sessions

Bestie Sessions are my favorite mini sessions! They are such a cute way to celebrate your best friend, significant other, pet, sibling, parent, grandparent or whoever that super special person is in your life!

College Sweater Mini Sessions

Already know where you plan to head to school next year? AMAZING! The biggest congratulations to you! If you want to celebrate by capturing some images rocking your college gear, let's do it!

What to Wear:

A super fun way to highlight your university is with a football or other sports jersey. If you are planning on playing a sport at college, you can also bring your own gear to use in these photos. If not, just grab a college tee, hoodie or crewneck. If you want to bring along your acceptance letter or a fun sign, we can capture that, too!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

These are some frequently asked questions that I get about common concerns. I've been doing this for over a decade, so I've seen it all. And I'm confident that we will get you amazing images no matter what gets thrown our way!

What happens if we have bad weather?

If there is bad weather in the forecast for your session, rest assured that you have options and I am more than happy to reschedule. I typically wait until we are 24-48 hours out from the session to make a final decision about weather because it changes so often.

Please Note: Rescheduling does not apply to Glacier Sessions. When in Glacier, we roll with whatever Glacier decides to give us! The plus side though, nothing can make Glacier National Park look bad.

Rain: It will be up to you and your parents whether you want to move forward with your session or if you'd prefer to reschedule to another date. If we go forward with the session and it does end up raining, we will have to finish the session despite the weather, we can't reschedule once hair and makeup starts. If you have your heart set on glowing light and bright images, I'd recommend rescheduling to be safe.

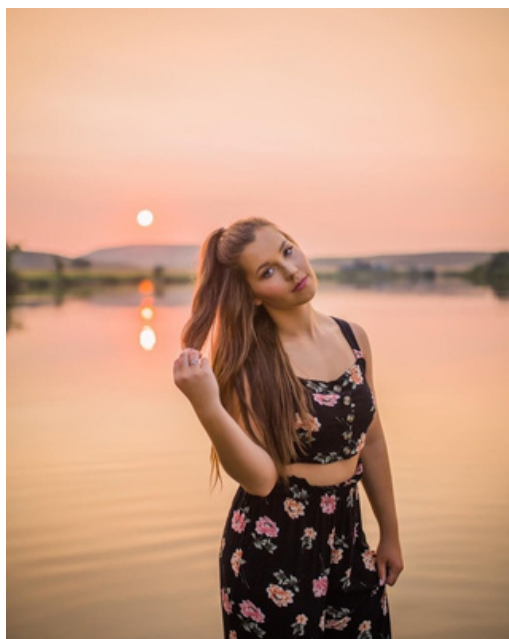
Wind: As we know, Great Falls is known for its crazy wind. If we are strategic with our locations, we can typically make moderate wind work. However, if there are high gusts, it is much better to reschedule. I'd rather photograph in the rain than in high wind!

Smoke: If there is smoke, it may will impact your images in some way. Depending on the severity of the smoke, the images could be slightly hazy with gray skies and no sunset. BUT I have created some really cool images with smokey skies as well. It all just depends on the particular day and will be up to you and your parents if you'd like to reschedule.

What if we DO reschedule because of weather?

That is COMPLETELY okay! We will make the final call 24-48 hours before your session. I always try to leave room open for rescheduling for reasons outside of our control (i.e. sickness, weather, emergencies). Typically, you won't have to wait longer than 2 weeks if we have to move your date!*

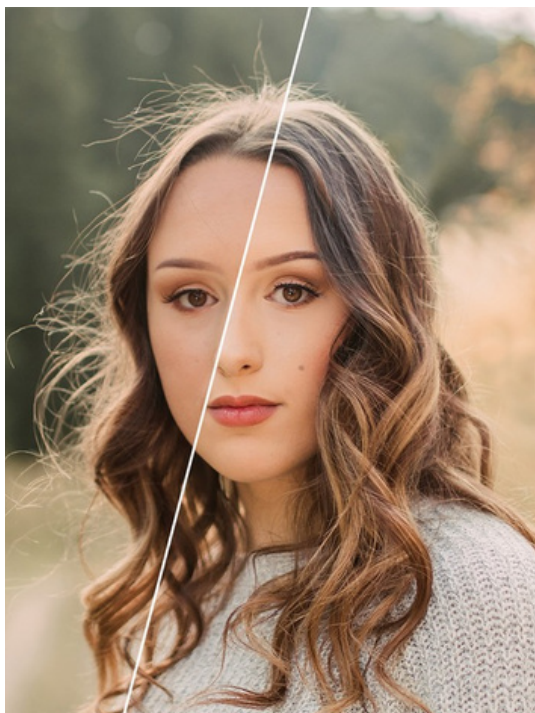
*This does NOT include needing to reschedule because of poor planning, running late or any other reason. These reschedules are required to book for my next available session date - which can be 2-3 months out.

Can you edit out my blemishes, tan lines and bra?

While blemishes are simply removed in editing; sunburns, tan lines and bras are not an easy fix. Please be cautious of how much time you are spending in the sun a few weeks prior to your portrait session. If you have unwanted tan lines, a professional hand-sprayed tan is a quick fix to even out your tan lines. As for bras, please make sure you are wearing the correct bra for EACH outfit. Patterns, embellishments and bright colors are not recommended and can be very distracting if shown through clothing. A simple nude bra with removable straps or adhesive covers work best for almost every outfit.

I am self-conscious of my body, can you edit it?

We all have our insecurities. We like to focus on posing and capturing angles that flatter the skin you're in. What we can't accomplish behind the camera, we can certainly work on in the editing process. We are not here to judge, we are here to help you feel your best.



What is your editing process?

We digitally retouch every image purchased at your print ordering session. We will lightly enhance each individual image as needed with color corrections, lighting enhancement, skin smoothing, stray hair removal and blemish removal. We want your images to look like YOU and be as natural as possible.

PHOTO GALLERIES

The next few pages of this guide will walk you through how to use your galleries. Be sure to come back and reference this after your session.

Optional professional print products are also available at an additional cost. We carry albums, wall art, gift prints, custom announcements and more. All of our print products are printed using professional labs that are only available to professional photographers.



The Review Gallery

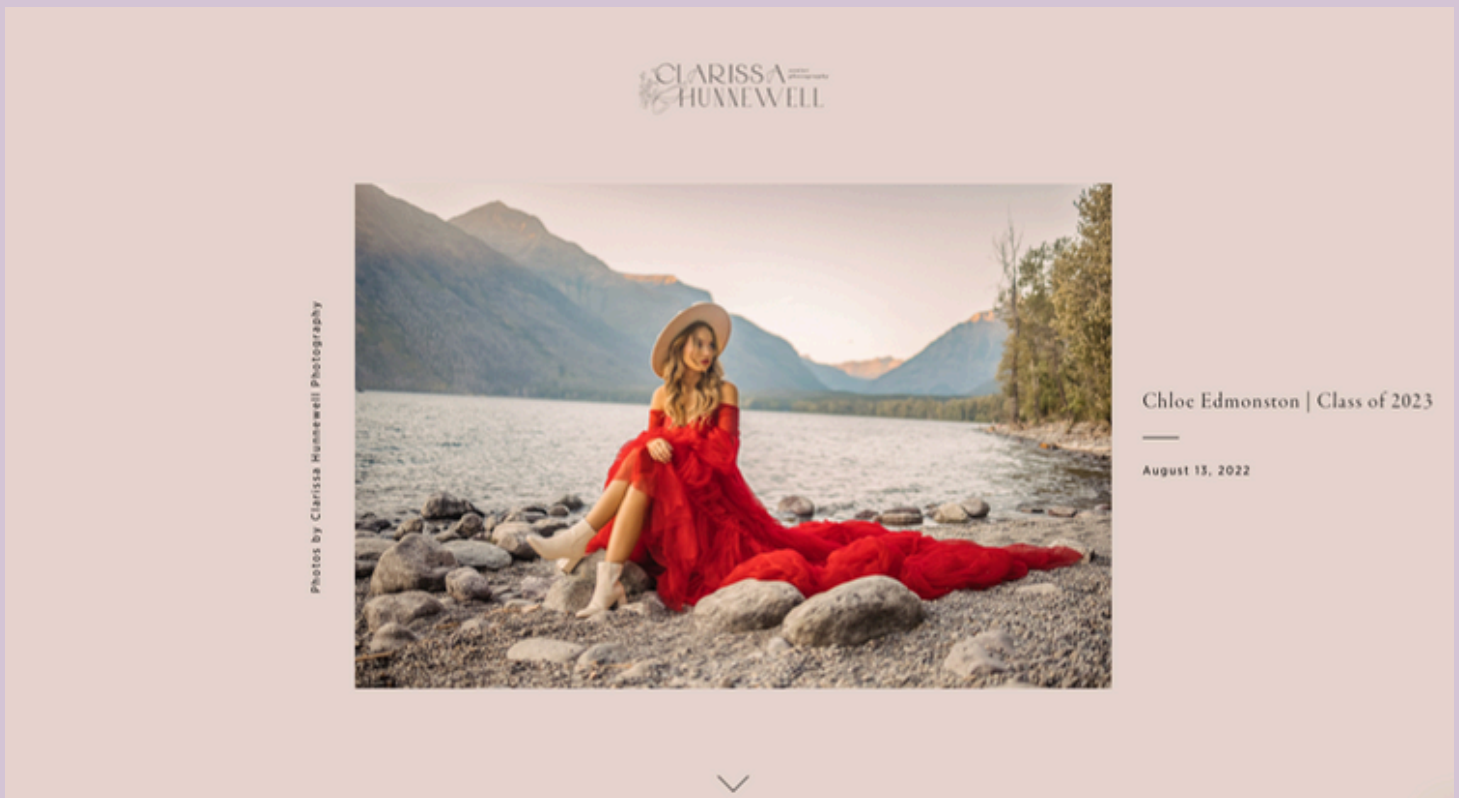
Approximately one week after your portrait session, you will receive a link to your review gallery with the unedited images from your portrait session. From there, you and your family will select your favorite images for me to edit.

The Final Gallery

Editing takes about 3 weeks. After the editing is finished, the images will be uploaded to your high resolution final gallery. There, you and your family are able to request additional editing, if needed.

Logging In

You will be prompted to log into your review gallery and final gallery with your email and password. This is for your safety and my records so I know who is viewing your gallery and downloading your images.

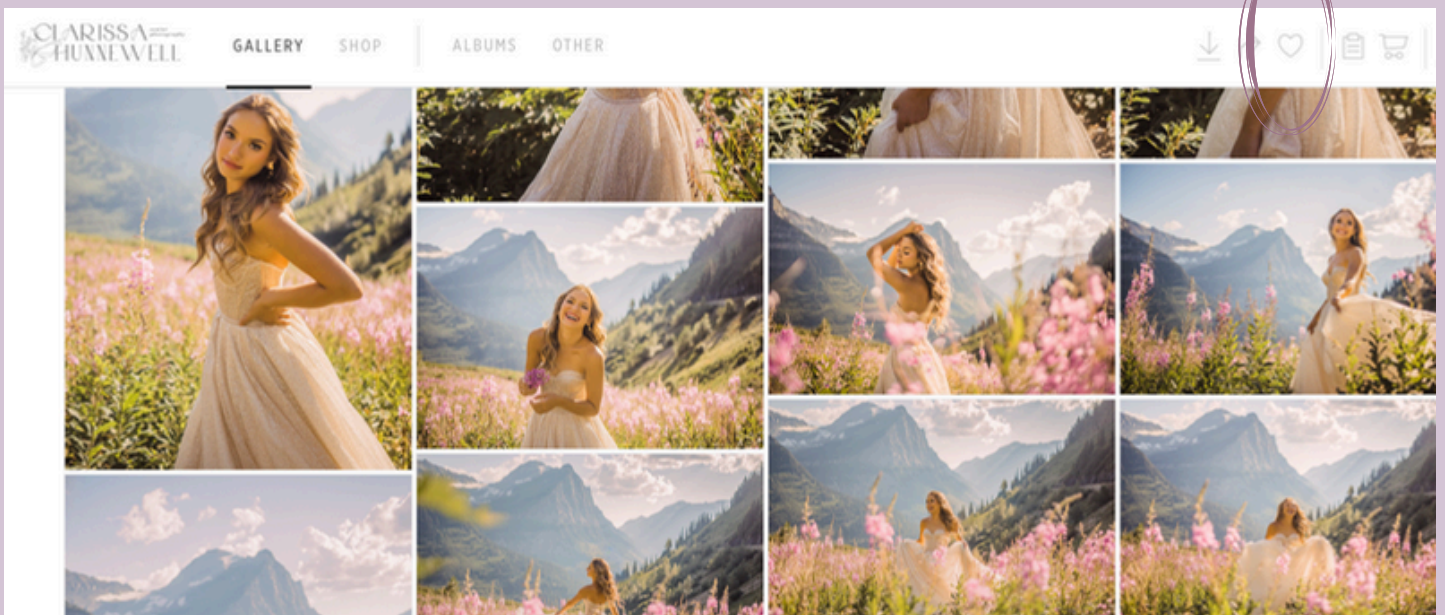


“Hearting” Your Images

You can "heart" your favorite images to make the selection process easier. I can also view the images you heart. This makes it simple for me to see the images you want edited and for me to help you order prints and products.

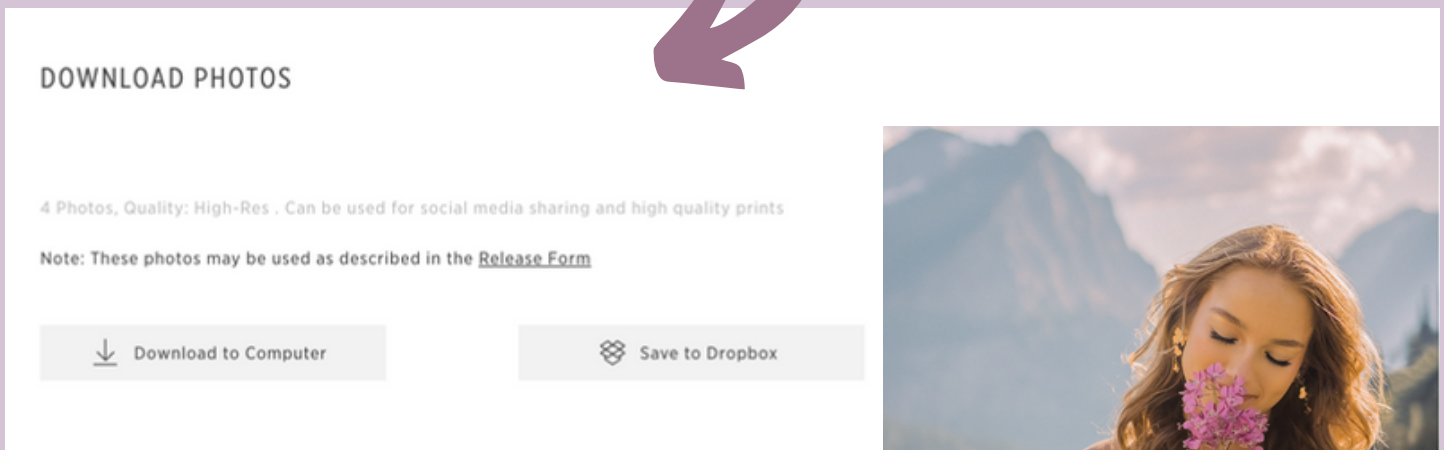
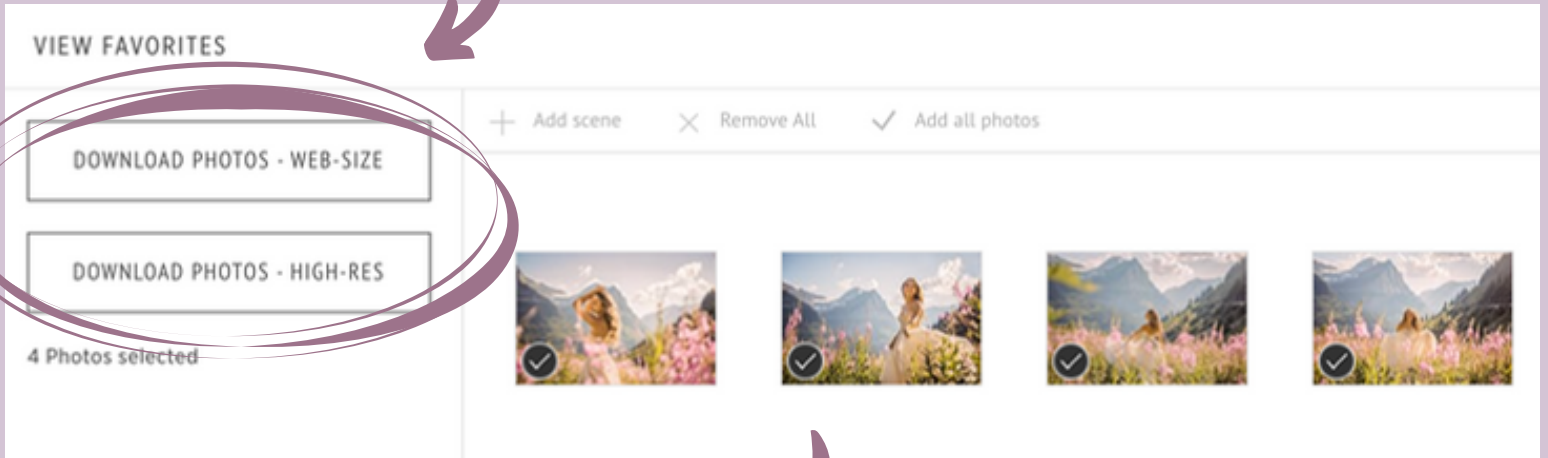


You can revisit your favorite images by choosing the heart icon/favorites button on the top right menu.



Downloading Your Images

There are a few ways to download and save your digital images to your computer. When you are looking at your high resolution final gallery, you can click the heart icon/favorites button again. This will give you the option to download all of the images in your favorite's list.



Or, you can click on an individual photo to download them one at a time.

TIP: Text your high resolution gallery link directly to your friends and family. They will be able to log in, view, download and order prints for themselves.

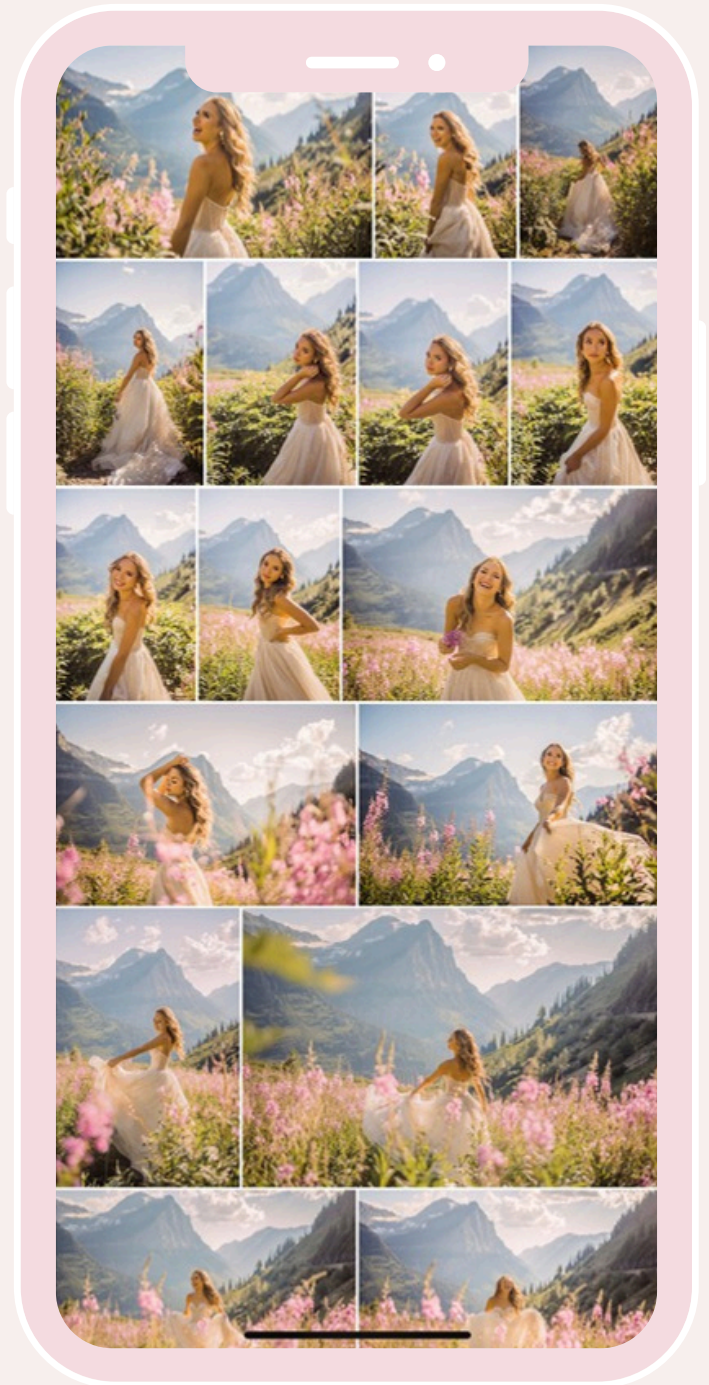


#SENIORSUNDAY

Sharing your images!

You can download your images to your phone the same way you download them on a computer.

For the best phone quality, I recommend downloading them directly from the gallery to your phone (don't screenshot). This way, you can easily share them on social media.



PRINTING YOUR IMAGES

I believe in the power of printing and displaying your images in your home. There is something so special about having a physical copy of these memories to cherish and potentially pass down to other family someday. My Great Grandparents had their children's senior portraits hung up in their home for over 50 years! You took the time to invest so much into your senior experience, why not print the images and have a physical way to cherish them and share them?

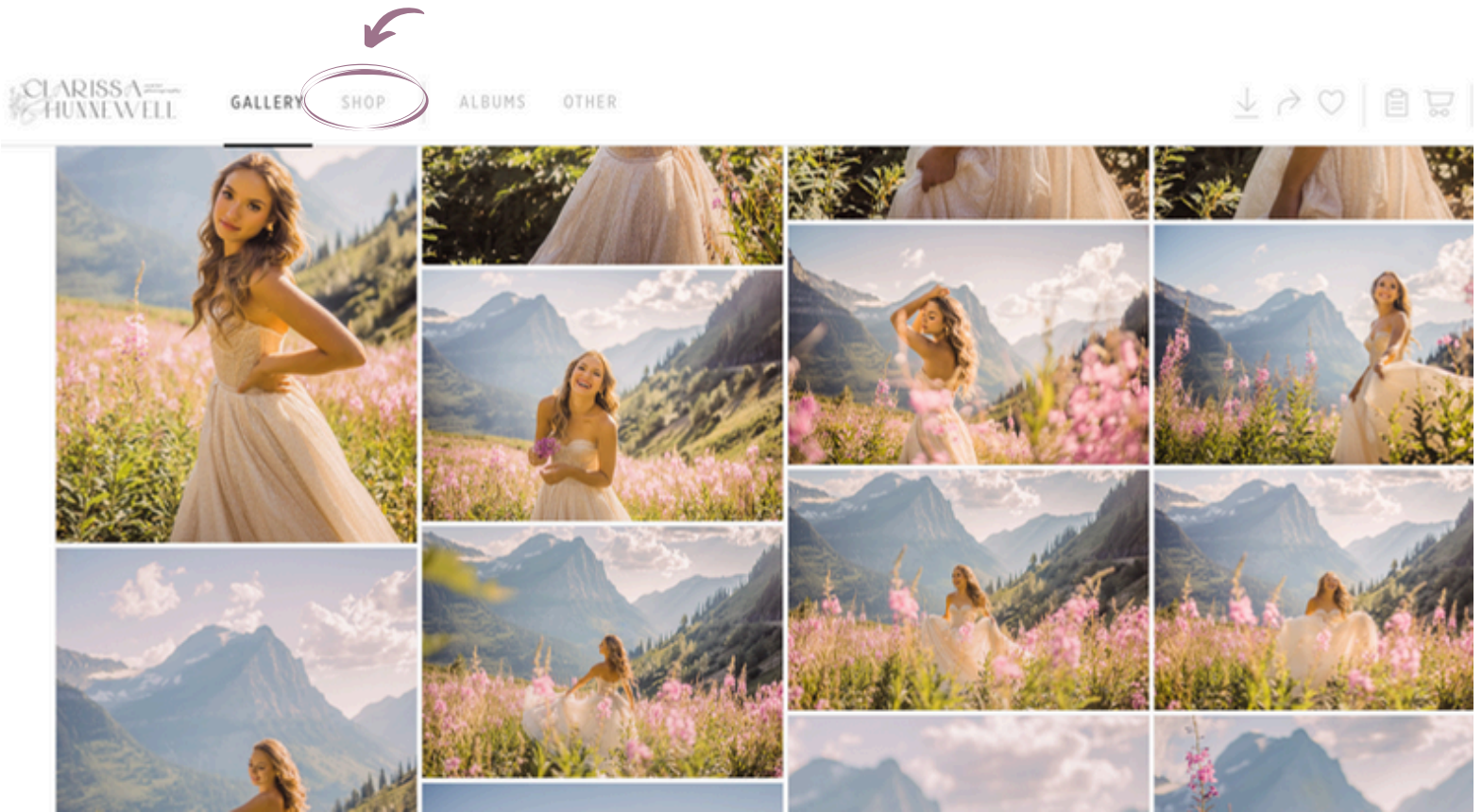
I do not have any purchase minimums or requirements in terms of printing your images, they are yours to share and print from wherever you prefer. However, there is the option to purchase professional-quality prints and products through your online final gallery. This is the ONLY printing option that I personally and professionally recommend in terms of quality and durability. If you print somewhere else, I can not guarantee that the quality of the images will look the same as they do online, or that the products and prints themselves will be durable. If you want to print your images larger than a 4x6, the professional printer through your online gallery is the best way to go.

In the next few pages, I am going to walk you through the "shop" portion of your final gallery. This is where you can find prints, albums, wall art and graduation cards, printed directly through my professional printer.

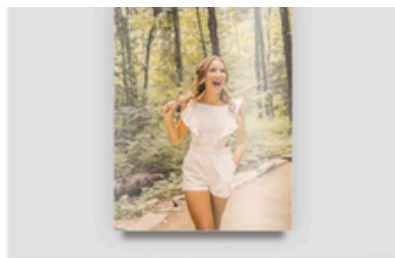


Accessing the Print Store

Using a desktop computer, when you are inside your final gallery you will see different options along the top, click "SHOP".

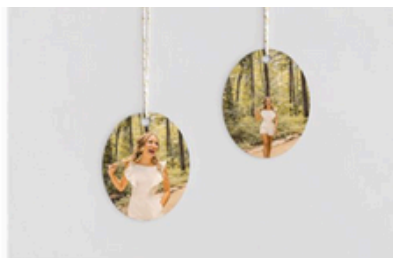


When you open up the shop, it should look similar to this. You will find all of the product options here.

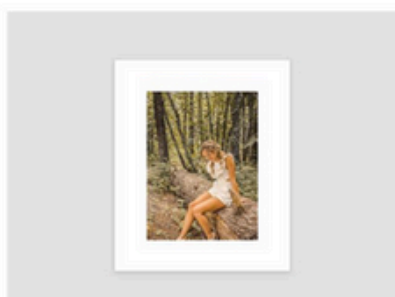

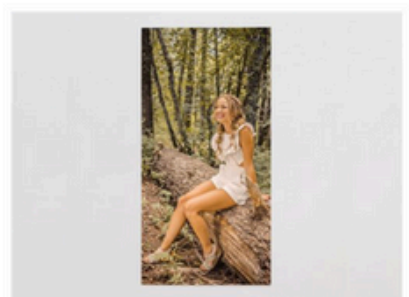
