

10 Honeymoon Packing Tips

1. Purchase your snacks before you get to the airport. Snacks in the airport can cost you almost double what you would pay in the store. Throw in your favorite granola bars, chips, and don't forget gum! The same goes for books and magazines. Tip: bring an empty reusable water bottle with you so you can fill it up throughout your trip to save money on bottles of water.
2. Download your airlines app so you can easily download your boarding pass for your flight. You can easily check in this way and receive updates. For all your other paper documents, buy a folder so everything can stay organized and safe in your bag.
3. Received new suitcases from your bridal shower? Make sure you add a tag or ribbon on them so you can easily and quickly identify it when you land. No one wants to be hanging out in the airport longer than they need to.
4. Download music, movies, and anything else you plan to enjoy on your flight before you leave. Most airlines make you pay for wifi and airport wifi isn't always the best.
5. Pack an extra pair of clothes in your carry-on. If you are going to a tropical place you may want to pack a bathing suit with you in case your room isn't ready when you arrive. Then you can just change quick in the bathroom instead of having to sift through your suitcase.
6. Don't forget about travel sizes! Remember 3-1-1. Bottles that are 3.4 oz or smaller that can fit in a 1 quart sized clear resealable bag can be scanned through security as part of your carry on. This is 1 per person. You can purchase these bottles at any Harmons, CVS, or Walgreens. Most of the products you use probably come in travel sizes too which saves you room when packing.
7. Airplanes can fluctuate in temperature so be sure to bring a sweater or jacket with you just in case.
8. If possible get TSA pre-checked. This will help you speed through security and you won't have to remove your shoes, jacket, laptop, belt, and liquids. You can apply right online then make an appointment at a local enrollment center. Give yourself 3-4 weeks for the whole process to be complete.
9. If you are traveling outside the US be sure your passport is up to date. Don't wait for the last minute or you will have to pay extra fees to have your passport expedited. The whole process can take 6-8 weeks.
10. Give yourself 2 hours to arrive at the airport and get through security. It's better to be early and relax then running through the airport stressed! If you are flying international tag on another hour to go through customs.
