



Codes of Conduct

All members of the Warrnambool Calisthenics Club will adhere to the following Codes of Conduct (excerpt)

(Members cover: Members/Pupils, Coaches, Assistants, Parents/Guardians, Volunteers and Spectators)

- Act as good role models and ambassadors of the Club at all times
- Display consistently high standards of good sporting behaviour and appearance

- Be trustworthy
- Never ridicule any participant, coach, assistant, club member or volunteer
- Display good sportsmanship, play by the rules and respect the adjudicators decisions
- Never use offensive behaviour or language
- Adhere to and support the Club's policies and guidelines

Participation

The Club instils the notion that calisthenics is a team sport and requires active participation of all team members. The Club understands that at times there may be circumstances that may prevent participation and will work with participants to find a mutually agreeable resolution.
