My strength is I am an Upcycle Deconstructed Clothing Designer. It is also my *cause* to help have sustainable fashion.

I love organizing wardrobes to discover combinations from our "leftover" clothing into more wearable pieces. It helps realize one's personal style from having bought them once and feeling more confident in choices.

As an experienced Patternmaker for iconic fashion brands, I see the connection in making pieces as a kind of puzzle that fit together.

The utility of upcycling opens the doors to participation in Sustainable Fashion making a global impact.

It lessens the Fast Fashion shopping addiction, and saves money too.

An inventory of our wardrobe finds unworn clothes; now resources for quality pieces like a vest, (I love vests), blouses, dresses, jackets, flowy t-shirts, or skirts.

Sometimes, it can only take sharp scissors, a measuring tape, some chalk, pins, a needle and thread, and tenacity to make the wardrobe of your dreams.

USE THIS FAVORITE
TECHNIQUE:

- DO NOT RIP OUT SEAMS
WITH A SEAM RIPPER -
- USE SHARP SCISSORS TO
CUT PIECES OUT.



A TUNIC SHIRT LIKE THIS-

FIND A SOFTER FABRIC SHIRT. CUT OFF THE SLEEVES AT DESIRED LENGTH (7"), AND COLLAR ON THE SEAM.

HEM SLEEVES WITH 1/4" ELASTIC(FOUND AS HANGER TAPE ON SOME GARMENTS) TO ROLL HEM SLEEVES OR HAND HEM ADDING A 1" TUCK ON THE OUTSIDE EDGE. SEW THE CUT SLEEVES ONTO THE NECKLINE PRACTICALLY ANY WAY YOU WANT.

Cut and Sew

MAKE A NEW DRESS.



Making the top part of the dress you can use a blouse, t-shirt, or another dress. Cut across the waist or five inches below the waist with the garment laying flat, or use the whole shirt without cutting.

For the skirt part of the dress always cut with as much length as possible because you can always make it shorter, measuring **up from the hem (keeping the original hem).**

Mark with chalk. Cut

Use Safety Pins-

Pin at CF, SS, and CB*

Sew together.

Your Needs and Desires



1. A DRESS-SEE THE GUIDE P. 7 FOR HOW TO COMBINE TWO PIECES.
2. FLOWY T-SHIRT, CUT-OUT SLEEVES 1/2" OUTSIDE OF SEAMS TO USE AND USE THE OLD SEAM AS A STITCH LINE. USE GOOD ORIGINAL HEMS AND NECKLINES, COMBINE-SEE PICTURE P.6.
3. A-LINE SKIRTS FOR TOPS, BY CUTTING ARMHOLES 9-10" RIGHT BELOW THE WAISTLINE AT THE SS. EXAMPLE ON THIS PAGE.
4. A NEW SUIT-CUT HORIZONTALLY ACROSS, ADD SOME LENGTH WITH ANOTHER SUIT BOTTOM OR CUT SHORT FOR A BOLERO, CHANGE OUT THE LAPEL BY APPLYING SOMETHING BRIGHTER ON TOP OF THE OLD ONE, ABOVE.
5. LONG SKIRT-YOU HAVE THIS, ADD DRESS LENGTH AFTER DRESS LENGTH, SEW TO PANTS BELOW THE POCKETS. JUST LIKE THE T-SHIRT SKIRT P.6.
6. HOSTESS OUTFIT-FOR THIS YOU CAN GET FUNKY, YOUR FRIENDS AND FAMILY WILL APPROVE.
7. CONCERT ATTIRE-LAYER IS KEY HERE. ADD POCKETS. MAKE NEW JACKETS.

FRIEND, HAVE FUN ON THIS JOURNEY, YOU ARE NOT GOING TO CUT UP ANY VALUABLE CLOTHING, (ANY CHANEL SUITS OR OTHER HIGH FASHION ITEM, ALTHOUGH PEOPLE ARE PAINTING ON LV BAGS, SEE HERE) SIMPLY EXTENDING THE LIFE OF PIECES TO ENHANCE YOUR INDIVIDUAL STYLE.

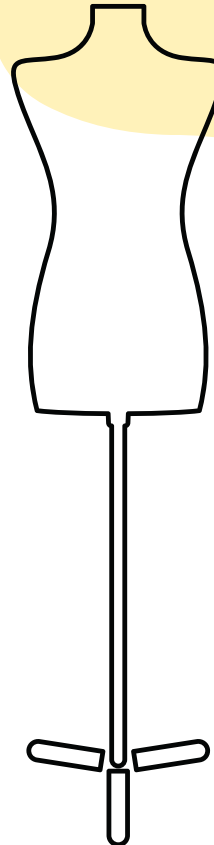
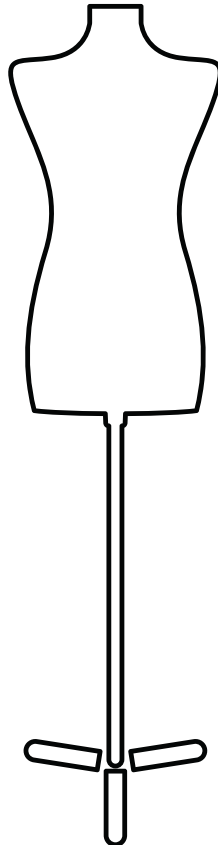
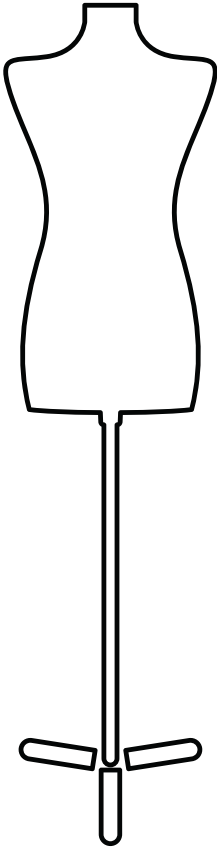
