- ① **Whirly Willow** • Grand glass trumpets bursting with white hydrangeas and freshly cut, natural-toned curly willow branches bridged the space between tables and arches to create a dramatic, yet intimate setting for the reception.
- ② **Great Balls of Flower** • Pomanders of white Fuji mums tinted with a Tiffany blue hue dangled from bridesmaids' wrists for a "hands-free" processional.
- ③ **It's Very Clear** • Their love is here to stay with this three-foot tall ice sculpture engraved with the couple's names and last initial.
- ④ **Blue Heaven** • Sweet Caroline's Cakes of Marietta, Georgia, recreated the definition of divine with a four-tier cake that boasted two layers of triple chocolate hazelnut cake, vanilla genoise, white chocolate mousse, dark chocolate ganache, and milk chocolate shavings. The remaining two layers were orange liqueur with strawberries and cream filling and butter pound cake filled with strawberry infusion and vanilla mousse. The design was iced with deep turquoise vanilla fondant and dark chocolate fondant damask embellishments that adorned cream cheese buttercream frosting.
- ⑤ **Raindrops on Roses** • Lyndsey carried a lush hand-tied bouquet of white hydrangea, white baby calla lilies, and white roses sparkling with crystals designed by Akeem Clayton of Bezaar Events in Atlanta—the perfect complement to her wedding gown accented with Swarovski crystals.
- ⑥ **Parting is Such Sweet Sorrow** • Chocolates bearing the couple's monogram design provided one last taste of the delicious evening.
