














#### When to book your **VENDORS**

- Photographer/videographer: 9-12 months in advance.
- Wedding dress: 9-12 months in advance.
- Band/DJ: 9-12 months in advance.
- Officiant: 9-12 months in advance.
- Decor/Floral: 9-12 months in advance.
- Hair and makeup artist: 6-9 months in advance.
- Transportation: 6-9 months in advance.
- Cake baker: 6-9 months in advance.
- Invitations: 6-9 months in advance.
- Bridal Party Outfit: 6 -9 months in advance.
- Honeymoon: 6- 9 months in advance.
- Transportation: 6-4 months in advance.
- Wedding favors: 4-2 months in advance.
- Send out invitations: 8 weeks.
- Finalize all the details with vendors: 8 3 weeks before the wedding.
