How to Journal

I have found that journaling after my daily read brings transformation at a whole new level. I start with a prayer asking God to show me what He wants me to see in my daily read. God will speak through His word, we just need to be ready to see and hear it. Before you read each day, prepare your heart and mind to receive.

Scripture

Find a verse or two that speaks to you. Everyday God has a truth in His word that will bring us more freedom and joy. Some will be to encourage, challenge, and inspire you to become everything God created you to be. The purpose of scripture isn't information, it is transformation.

Application

Write down how you will apply this verse to your every day life. Your daily read should take you from knowledge to obedience. Throughout the Bible, God shows us the blessing we have in obeying His Word. Find a truth each day and apply it.

Prayer

Finish with a prayer. Prayer is one of the greatest gifts and weapons the Lord gives us to live in victory every day of our life. Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you and empower you to carry out the task ahead of you.

Imagine that - one of the greatest servants of Christ to ever walk the planet is giving you his last words! I would lean in and take notes, and that is exactly what you should do with this book. Paul, who has run the race and fought the good fight, is now passing the baton to his disciple Timothy, but he is also passing it to you and me.

He is going to challenge you to not grow apathetic in your mission, but to fight and keep the passion of your calling. **You and I are called**.

A calling is a word you will see throughout the Bible. The simplest way to share with you what a calling *is*, would be to tell you what it *isn't*. Your calling isn't a job. It's not something you quit or move on from. *It is who you are*. It is one of the greatest reasons you are alive. None of us are saved by works. The Bible makes that very clear. But the Bible also makes it very clear that we are saved to do a great work. Paul is challenging us to never forget that. You and I have a great mission ahead of us, and we must not get sidetracked.
