**Entries accepted online via BHP.HorseSpot.Net or in the show office beginning at 7:30 AM. Entries must be received by 2 PM the day prior to the show to receive discount.**

**Cards will be processed at the conclusion of the show.**

All exhibitors must wear USEF approved protective head gear, correctly fitted, when mounted. Sleeves and Boots with heel required. Formal attire is preferred in Hunter ring. In cases of extreme heat, jackets may be restricted by show management.

Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve awarded to High Point Rider/Horse at each division with more than 3 riders. NOTE: Points are awarded using the basic USEF scale of 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 0.5.

Cross entering classes is done at the risk of the competitor. Classes will be held for a not more than 5 minutes for tack change or repair. Children's Ring WILL NOT be held for Hunter

Age-restricted classes use the rider's age as of December 1, 2025.

Marshall & Sterling League and Colonial Classic requirements are the responsibility of the competitor. Please check their websites for registration information.

Show management reserves the right to combine, divide, cancel or change the order or location of any class.

The judge's and/or show management's decisions in regard to class standings is final. Please direct questions and concerns to the show management.

The show will be held rain or shine except in the case of extreme weather conditions. Please call the office at (610) 847-8597 to verify.

### *Marshall & Sterling League Class Specifications*

Three riders must complete the course for points to count. Riders are responsible for requirements and ensuring classes are full before competing. Show management does not guarantee filled classes.

#### M&S Children's/Adult Hunter Classic Division (S/M/L/Horse)

Open to Jr or Am riders. To be run as a two-round classic with class 36 run as the flat class for division points. Run as open card with heights combined for pinning. Classes 34 and 35 must both be entered and will be run following classes 26, 38, and 44 respectively.

#### 100. M&S Bit o' Straw Classic (2'6")

Open to Jr or Am riders. No cross entry into Hunter Classics or 3'. Two round classic run at the conclusion of class 38.

#### 101. M&S Jumper Classic

Open to Jr or Am riders. Horses must compete in one other class. Shown over Course 1 Jump Off B at the conclusion of each height. Specify height at check in. Run as open card with heights combined for pinning.

#### 103. M&S Pre-Child/Adult Hunter Classic (2' Set Height)

Open to Jr or Am riders. No cross entry into classes above 2'6". Two round classic run at the conclusion of class 26.

#### 104. M&S Low Children's/Adult Hunter Classic (2'6" Set Height)

Open to Jr or Am riders. No cross entry into classes above 3'. Two round classic run at the conclusion of class 38.

#### 105. M&S Children's/Adult Medal (S/M/L/Horse)

Open to Jr or Am riders. Run as open card with heights combined for pinning, will be run following classes 23 and 41 respectively. Courses to include direction changes and tests.

#### 107. Adult/Children's Medal (2'6" Set Height)

Open to Jr or Am riders. No cross-entry of rider into Pony Medal or 3' classes at the same show. Run at the conclusion of class 41.

#### 108. M&S Leadline

To be judged on the manners and suitability of pony/horse to rider. No cross-entry outside of leadline. To be run after class 83.

To qualify, a rider must be a member of a participating local horse show series. Riders - through their respective horse show series - accumulate points in their division or divisions beginning January 1, 2026 through mid-August.

Riders/Horses must submit a nomination form listing their Colonial Classic divisions by July 20th. The top 3 riders in each of our divisions (by points) will be names as nominees in their corresponding Colonial Classic division. If a rider qualifies for multiple divisions based on their point standing, we will nominate them for their priority Colonial Classic division then nominate the rider listed below them in other divisions to allow the most riders/horses to participate.

In Hunter Classes, points will be awarded to the HORSE.  
In Equitation Classes, points will be awarded to the RIDER.  
Pleasure and Jumper points will be awarded to the same HORSE and RIDER combination.  
Children's Ring points are awarded to the RIDER.

Trainers wishing to participate in the annual Trainer's Award must be registered in the Year-End Awards Program.

We will be using your best 8 shows (highest accumulated points) to tally your points for year-end standings. Additional shows completed will not be used for point tallying purposes.

## Scoring of Jumper Classes

### Course 1 ~ Table II, Sec. 2 (b)

The first round and first jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If a competitor has gone clear in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jumpoff course. If there are no clear rounds and a tie exists for first place, the results will be determined by the scores and time from that round



### Course 2 ~ Table IV Sec. 2 (c)

If a competitor has gone clear in the first piece, he will, upon crossing the finish line, commence the designated jump-off, with time starting as the horse crosses the finish line for the initial course. In the case of equality of faults in the jump-off, ties will be broken on the following basis: horse with the time on course closest to this Optimum Time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc. If there are no clear rounds, a jump-off, scored as described above, will take place among those tied for first place.

### ELIMINATION FOR THE FOLLOWING

Third disobedience anywhere on course, exceeding Time Limit, resisting forward movement for 45 sec., taking 45 sec. to jump the first obstacle after the round has begun, taking 45 sec. to jump the second obstacle on course, fall of horse and/or rider, jumping an obstacle before it is reset or without waiting for the signal to proceed, starting before the start signal, failure to cross the start line within 45 sec., off course, failure to enter arena after 1 (one) minute of being called, leaving the arena before finishing the course, abuse or excessive use of whip or spurs any time within the arena.
