OUR VISION

Our vision for the beingHER Safe Space is to create a secure and inviting environment for girls aged 11-18, offering them a place to go after school and on weekends, especially those whose parents/guardians work late or multiple jobs. We've designed the space with input from the girls in our community, ensuring it reflects a comfortable, dreamy home-away-from-home atmosphere.

Here, girls can engage in 1-on-1 conversations with our youth support workers, utilise our small study area, participate in workshops and sessions in our cozy circle time space, or simply enjoy our evening movie nights. We hope this space serves as a safe haven for girls in Croydon and beyond, providing a nurturing ground where they can flourish.

Whenever possible, we invite the parents of the girls who attend our Safe Space to visit and view the space themselves, to allow them peace of mind about the safety and environment their daughters are in.



BEINGHER SAFE SPACE FEATURES

1-2-1 SUPPORT



At our Safe Space, we offer 1-on-1 drop-in sessions where girls can speak openly with our youth workers about anything on their minds. These sessions provide a confidential and supportive environment for girls to discuss their thoughts, concerns, or aspirations.

STUDY AREA



Our Safe Space includes a dedicated study area designed for girls to come and focus on their academic work. Whether they need a quiet spot to revise for exams or require assistance with homework, our study area is equipped to support their educational needs.

READING CORNER



featuring a cozy reading corner, with a range of books perfect for girls who want to unwind and enjoy some quiet time. This welcoming nook provides a comfortable spot for them to escape into a book, whether they're waiting for someone to be home after school or simply seeking a peaceful retreat from their day-to-day.

MOVIE EVENINGS



We host movie evenings at our Safe Space, The girls can enjoy a selection of films alongside a small group of peers. It's a great way for them to make new friends, enjoy some downtime, and feel part of a welcoming community.

IN MEMORY OF ELIANNE ANDAM

The beingHER Safe Space is dedicated to the memory of Elianne Andam, a 15-year-old schoolgirl whose life was tragically cut short by senseless knife attack on her way to school.

We have worked closely with her family to ensure we can do this in a sensitive and empowering way, the beingHER Safe Space honours her legacy, inspiring all who enter with her bravery, love, and hope.

A special corner of the safe space features a swing and a cloud feature wall, along with a plaque dedicated to Elianne.

Here, girls can take Polaroid pictures and post them on the wall around her plaque, creating a living tribute that honors her memory and keeps her spirit alive in our community.
