Through our medical outreach and medical centers, we have been able to provide healthcare for many. We have offered basic medical care, seen preventable diseases cured, and had major surgeries performed. Over 9,000 patients seen in the last year.

Our medical center has:

- examined 2,700 out-patients treated.
- treated 250 in-patients recovered.
- performed over 125 surgeries.
- helped over 25 labor and delivery patients.
- provided over 100 x-rays.
- conducted over 500 ultrasounds.
- administered over 2,500 labs on patients.
