God's Word is wonderful. God's Word has given me peace and strengthened me while facing death. I would like to show you from God's Word how you can emerge from a dark time stronger than you were before.

Satan's end game is to destroy your faith. Don't blame God. Jesus said to Peter, "Satan has desired to sift you as wheat, but I have prayed for you that your faith fail not." -Luke 22:31-32

Satan's ability to destroy your life hinges on you allowing your faith to fail. The easiest thing to do when faced with devastation is to abandon God and His Word. Don't run from God in the time of trouble—run to God! It will save your life.

"The generous will prosper; those who refresh others will themselves be refreshed."

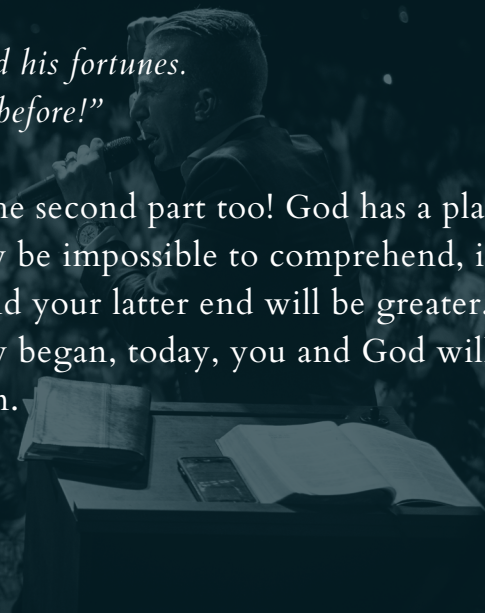
seven
