

• Ideal Room Size: 500-800 sq. ft. (e.g., a large hotel suite, conference room or bridal lounge)

• Setup Considerations:

- 1-2 makeup stations (table with good lighting, mirror, and chair)
- 1-2 hairstyling stations (chair, table for tools/products, and an outlet nearby)
- Living room and bedroom are separate
- Comfortable seating for the bridal party to relax
- Natural light is a plus for makeup artists
- Space for the dress, accessories, and photos




For 10-15 People (Including Bride, Bridal Party & Artists)

Ideal Room Size: 800-1200 sq. ft. (e.g., a large hotel suite, conference room or spacious Airbnb)


• Setup Considerations:

- 2-3 makeup stations
- 2-3 hairstyling stations
- Living room, dining area and bedroom are separate
- Multiple power outlets and extension cords
- Additional chairs and seating areas for those waiting
- Space for a dress-changing area,
 photographer movement, and refreshments



Key Factors for a Smooth Getting-Ready Experience

- Lighting: Natural light is ideal, but if unavailable, bright, adjustable artificial lighting is necessary.
- Ventilation & Temperature: Heat tools and multiple people can make the room hot — good airflow is important. Dress steaming should be in a separate room from hair & makeup!
- Electrical Outlets: Have multiple outlets or power strips to avoid delays.
- Separation of Open Spaces: The photographer can take details shot in your bedroom, while glam takes place in the living area.
- The more space, the better for a calm and organized morning.
