# HELPFUL HINTS FOR YOUR ENGAGEMENT Session

#### TIMLINESS

Because we schedule our session according to the best lighting of the day, it is imperative we are on time. Of course things happen that may set us back a few minutes, so planning to be there 15 minutes ahead of our scheduled time may not be a bad idea.

### **PROPS**

Consider bringing items along that represent your relationship, the place you met, activities you enjoy together...maybe a basket with glasses and a bottle of wine is appropriate? For more ideas, a Google search of "stylized engagement shoots" should return some great results.

# **OUTFITS**

I typically recommend couples bring one additional outfit to the session to add some variety to the shoot. However, this is NOT mandatory. If you have one outfit you love and wanna' rock it the whole time, go for it! One casual and one dressy will be plenty.

# POSING

This is MY job. Not yours. I will tell you exactly what to do, so do NOT worry! Almost all couples are nervous about their first session in front of the camera, so you're not alone. I promise I won't let you look silly! You will be amazing.

## HAIR AND MAKUP (LADIES)

This is the perfect time to get a look at how your hair and makeup will look in front of the camera. I recommend you consider having your hair and makeup professionally done, or investing the time into ensuring that you have a look you are happy with.

### NAILS

This is an engagement session, so be warned that your ring WILL be photographed. A lot. That being said, your hands (especially the left one) will be highlighted in your photos. For this reason, you may want to consider having your nails done prior to your session. Any excuse to get pampered for a day, right?

### HAVE FUN

This session is meant to capture the love you share, and that should be FUN! So, relax and look forward to this time ahead of you, and consider it an adventure. We will have a great time!
