CONNECT

 - •When God closes a door or changes your plans, what's your natural reaction? What would it look like to respond with surrender instead of frustration?
- •What are some common reasons we hesitate to move when God gives direction? What helps you take that step of obedience, even when it doesn't make sense?
- •Why do you think God often reveals His direction one step at a time instead of showing us the whole plan? How does that test or strengthen your trust in Him?

What is one area in your life right now where you sense God might be giving direction, or redirection, but you've hesitated to move? What would it look like to take the "next right step" this week?
