Viper Athletics is open to all 4th - 8th grade student-athletes! To begin your student-athlete(s) registration please create an account/log in to Register My Athlete by visiting <https://registermyathlete.com/login/> and complete all of the registration requirements outlined. For planning purposes, we ask that you complete the registration process for ALL sports your student-athlete(s) plans to participate in throughout the 2023-2024 school year as soon as possible.

All student-athletes are required to have a completed [sports](#) physical dated after June 1, 2023 using only the form provided by CAA. A printed copy of the CAA sports physical form is available in the front office for your convenience.

Please note that a student-athlete will NOT be permitted to participate/tryout for any sport until all of the steps outlined in Register My Athlete are completed and approved by the Athletic Director and Assistant Principal, Tom Pasinski.

Athletic Participation Fees: Elementary Division \$135 (Grades 4-6), Junior High Division Team 2: \$160 (Grades 5-8), Junior High Division Team 1: \$185 (Grades 5-8), Cross Country \$200 (Grades 5-8); fees to be paid by listed due date.

A multi-sibling discount of 20% is applied to the higher athletic fee for all families with more than one student-athlete participating during the same season. This discount does NOT include participation in Jr. Vipers.

Val Vista Academy relies on our approved parent drivers to get all of our student-athletes to and from all offsite practice and away games/meets.


To become an approved parent driver, you must meet the following requirements to be approved by the school. Please note: You will **NOT** be allowed to transport **ANY** athletes other than your own, even with the permission from another parent, unless this information is on file with the school.
