- **To break - broke**

- He broke the glass.

- **To catch - caught**

- She caught the ball.

- **To fly - flew**

- They flew to Paris.

- **To teach - taught**

- She taught English last year.

- **To think - thought**

- He thought about the problem.

- **To speak - spoke**

- She spoke to her friend.

- **To hide - hid**

- He hid the birthday gift under the sofa.

- **To send - sent**

- They sent an email.

- **To swim - swam**

- She swam in the ocean.

- **To feel - felt**

- He felt happy yesterday.

- **To bring - brought**

- She brought a cake to the party.

- **To fight - fought**

- They fought in the war.

- **To hear - heard**

- I heard a strange noise.

- **To hold - held**

- She held the baby in her arms.

- **To lead - led**

- He led the team last year.

- **To leave – left**

- She left the office early yesterday.

- **To ride – rode (rijden; NIET autorijden, dat is “DRIVE”)**

- She rode her bike to school.

- **To steal - stole**

- Someone stole my wallet.

- **To eat - ate**

- I ate breakfast early.

- **To drink - drank**

- She drank a glass of water.

- **To drive - drove**

- He drove to work.

- **To sit - sat**

- She sat on the chair.

- **To stand - stood**

- He stood in line.

- **To sleep - slept**

- I slept well last night.

- **To wake - woke**

- She woke up early.

- **To meet - met**

- We met at the café.

- **To buy - bought**

- He bought a new laptop.

- **To pay - paid**

- She paid the bill.

- **To read - read** (uitgesproken als "red")

- I read the book yesterday.

- **To win - won**

- They won the game.

- **To choose - chose**

- She chose the blue dress.

- **To forget - forgot**

- He forgot his keys.

- **To grow - grew**

- The plant grew quickly.

- **To build - built**

- They built a new house.

- **To sell - sold**

- He sold his car.

- **To wear - wore**

- She wore a beautiful dress.

- **To understand - understood**

- He understood the instructions.

- **To be - was/were**

- I was at home yesterday. // You were at home yesterday.

- **To have - had**

- They had a great time yesterday.

- **To do - did**

- He did his homework.

- **To go - went**

- We went to the park.

- **To get - got**

- They got new phones.

- **To make - made**

- She made dinner last night.

- **To know - knew**

- I knew the answer.

- **To take - took**

- She took a photo.

- **To see - saw**

- I saw a movie.

- **To come - came**

- She came home late.

- **To say - said**

- He said goodbye.

- **To find - found**

- They found the keys.

- **To give - gave**

- She gave him a gift.

- **To tell - told**

- He told a story.

- **To put - put**

- He put the book on the table.

- **To begin - began**

- The meeting began at 9 AM.

- **To cry - cried**

- She cried when she heard the sad news.

- **To keep - kept**

- He kept the secret.

- **To write - wrote**

- I wrote a letter.

- **To run - ran**

- She ran in the marathon.

- **To lose - lost**

- She lost her keys yesterday.

- **To cut – cut (knippen / snijden)**

- He cut the paper with scissors.

- **To fall - fell**

- She fell down the stairs.

- **To forgive - forgave**

- He forgave her after the argument.

- **To shake - shook**

- He shook my hand.

- **To try - tried**

- She **tried** to open the door.
