If your wedding gallery is like a book, the details are the acknowledgments

Yeah, you get to take home your invitation suite at the end of the day, but what about the more sentimental pieces? Like your grandmother's ring, your something borrowed - those little things! These may not go back home with you, but they played an important role on your wedding day, and should not be forgotten.

# Detail Box

These items should go in a little box or bag, ready for me to grab! **Pro tip:** keep someone in charge of always knowing where it is. Then when I arrive and ask for your details you can be like "talk to Katie!"

- Full invitation suite
- Extra envelope
- Both wedding bands
- Your engagement ring
- All your jewelry
- Perfume
- Heirloom items
- Styling florals

### Detail Box

Some notes on a couple of these items:

Extra envelope: especially if it's a wedding color, there's fancy script or a special lining

Heirloom items: This is usually your something borrowed! Other jewelry or a handkerchief, things like that. Oftentimes there will be something specific (like a special ring) for your wedding day that's been passed down by all the women in the family. Stuff like that! Ask your mom:)

Styling Florals: ask your florist if they can put florals and greenery aside for the details! Sometimes they will tack on like 10 bucks for this, just FYI! That would be a really sweet little gift for your photographer...!

# Have on hand

These are items that I'll need, but simply will not fit in a box :) It's super helpful if they're nearby (you can have Katie be in charge of these too!)

- Shoes
- Your bouquet
- Boutonnieres
- Dress + special hanger
- Veil
- Grooms' details:
  - Cufflinks
  - Watch
  - Tie/Bowtie
  - Shoes
  - Any special details
     (family heirlooms, etc.)

### ~ Extras! ~

Now we have come to the things that really make your details your own! These are items that are not at all necessary, but I definitely recommend!

- Ring box
- Trays
- Jewelry dishes
- Reception details
- Silk ribbon
- Fabric

### ~ Extras! ~

Some notes on a couple of these items:

Ring Box: the most popular are Mrs. Boxes. You can also head to Etsy to find a more unique one. There are waaaay more styles than you think!!

Trays/Dishes: These could be antique or modern, maybe a special heirloom or your favorite dish from your kitchen! They give your detail photos a lot of personality and depth.

Reception Details: Paper goods like your menu or place cards, any linens that tie the theme together – special, unique things like that! (side note, no need to include your koozies, I'll get those later!

Ribbon/Fabric: Just like the linens, anything that goes with your colors or theme! Ribbon and fabric add beautiful texture and help tie your details all together!

# Optional Details

Look through these and see if there are any that you'd like photographed! I don't always ask for these, but am happy to include them if you'd like!

- Garter
- Bridesmaids dresses
- + hangers
- \*If you want this shot, ask your bridesmaids to make sure their dresses are all on their hangers and in the same spot! This one can take more time than you think.
  - Head/hair piece
- \*I'll get it back to you before it needs to go in your hair, promise!
