More Information about Camp at Triple R Ranch

Camps: Triple R Ranch offers more than one type of camp experience! See the front of the registration form for dates and prices.

Adventure Camp Camp is Sunday through Friday. Check-in is Sunday at 5:00pm and check-out is Friday at 5:00pm each week.

Campers rotate through Morning Skill Area activities each morning with their cabin mates through a different schedule of skill areas each day (see Morning Skill Areas below). Afternoons are spent at the pool, playing games, more skills at optional electives (additional fees - see front of registration form), or hanging out with friends at the camp store, the "Trading Post." In the evening, all campers enjoy Bible discovery hour and camp-wide programs that round out the day.

Mini Camp Camp is Sunday through Friday. Check-in is Sunday at 5:00pm and check-out is Wednesday at 5:00pm.

Campers enjoy a shortened version of Adventure Camp and can relax, knowing they won't be away from home for so long.

Day Camp Camp is Monday through Friday. Check-in each day is 8:00am and check-out is 5:00pm each day.

Campers enjoy the best Morning Skill Area activities and their own Bible discovery hour and time in the camp store, the "Trading Post" in the afternoon while spending their overnights at home. See each camp date for specific ages.

Morning Skill Areas: Campers travel with their cabin mates through a schedule of exciting Skill Areas. The following is an example of what to expect. Skill Areas are subject to change.

Archery - Master the bow and arrow with time at the archery range.

Archery Tag (NEW!) - Dodgeball-style archery with arrows that have foam tips.

Barn Tour - Learn what is involved in caring, grooming, and staying safe around horses.

Canoeing - Get on the Northwest River to explore and perfect rowing strokes.

Challenge Courses - Work together as a cabin to overcome the challenge of our low ropes courses.

Climbing Wall - Scale to the top of our 40 ft. high climbing tower and ring the bell.

Critter Corral - Meet our small farm animals and learn why each one is important.

Escape Room - Gather clues and solve a mystery as a group.

Flying Squirrel - Strap in a harness and experience a moment of "flying" with the help of teammates on the other end of a harness and pulley system.

Horseback Riding - Every camper gets the opportunity to mount up and take a ride.

Laser Tag - Experience the excitement of laser tag with multiple modes of game play.

Leather Craft - Learn the art of tulling the leather and making a custom piece to take home.

Nature - Become more aware of our environment as you study what can be found in nature.

Swimming Pool - Enjoy the Water Slide, swimming, diving boards, and games at the pool.

Target Shooting - Learn safely the skill of target shooting.

Wallyball - This fun indoor game is like volley ball in a racquetball court.

Horsemanship Electives: Ages 8-14. For Adventure and Day Camp ONLY. Additional Fees apply (see front of form).

Horsemanship Track This is for campers who want to spend more time with horses and go further in their horse handling skills. Two hours each morning of the week are spent at the stables learning to ride and take care of horses.

Private Riding Lesson A one-on-one horseback riding lesson tailored to the individual's needs.

Additional Trail Ride A 45-minute group horseback trail ride in addition to the one campers are already scheduled for with their cabin.

Afternoon Electives: Campers may choose any or all of these afternoon activities. For Adventure Camp ONLY. Additional fees apply (see front of form):

Archery Tag (NEW!) Dodgeball-style archery with arrows that have foam tips.

Flying Squirrel Strap in a harness and experience a moment of "flying" with the help of teammates on the other end of a harness and pulley system.

Riflery Learn to handle and fire a rifle safely.

Archery Master the bow and arrow with time at the archery range.

Trading Post, the Camp Store

The Trading Post is the camp store where campers get an opportunity each day to purchase snacks and souvenirs. Many snack options are available like chips, cookies, crackers, ice cream, water, soda, juice, etc. Souvenirs available vary from year-to-year but always include t-shirts, bandanas, bumper stickers, reusable water bottles, and other items to remind campers of their time at camp.

Parents pre-pay an amount for each camper's account before the week arrives. Campers will only be able to make purchases on their account and not with physical money; it is against camp rules for campers to bring money with them to camp. If they do, it will be turned into the office and can be picked up at the end of the week.

Online, parents are able to go to the virtual Trading Post and purchase Care Packages, an exclusive yearly edition camp t-shirt, and other items to enhance the camp experience. Not everything available in the store is available online. Parents will have opportunities at check-in and check-out to shop the actual store.

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If for any reason you must cancel, a written notice must be submitted to our office. Session changes require a \$15 processing fee (waived until May 1, 2019) accompanied by written notice.
