

CUSTOMER OWN MATERIAL (COM)

We accept COM and COL orders. Please see our "COM TAG" form which is attached.
A "Ship To" address will be provided on our order acknowledgement.

SERVICE FEE:

We require a service fee of \$150 for processing each COM and COL order which will be added to your invoice.

LEATHER (COL):

To calculate leather, use the conversion of 18 square feet of leather = 1 yard of 54" wide fabric, when using approximately 45 square foot usable hides.

- Jobber or mill shipping errors
- Mismarked COM's
- Suitability, wearability, color fastness or dye lot variations
- Shrinkage, stretching or color fading
- Returning excess fabric
- Flaws, snags, runs or any other material defect
- Fabric creases due to shipping folded instead of on a roll. Every effort is made to steam out creases but cannot be guaranteed

FABRIC BACKING:

Many fabrics require backing to stabilize the weave before use in upholstery. Some fabrics which are light in color must also be backed to prevent a transparent appearance of the fabric. Several types of backing are available including knit bond, latex and acrylic. Each of these is used to stabilize the weave of the fabric and should be used whenever the fabric tends to pull apart easily or is to receive excessive use. Knit backing should be applied on thinner, transparent or light colored fabrics. If it is questionable whether your COM is appropriate for the specified upholstery application, we will contact you for a call tag for your fabric backer.

FABRIC INSPECTION:

Fabric packages are inspected just prior to upholstery. We reserve the right to refuse COM if deemed unsuitable. Also note that some imperfections are difficult to recognize. We are not responsible for defects, imperfections and other flaws, and recommend fabrics inspected prior to shipment.

COM YARDAGE GUIDE:

- All COM yardage requirements are based on 54" wide plain or textured fabric that requires no matching and is cut to the best possible yield consistent with good appearance and tailoring.
- For fabrics less than the 54" standard width and/or with a fabric repeat, additional yardage will also be required. Please supply this additional yardage based on the following chart, rounding up the next half-yard increment. This chart works well with most fabrics and is intended as a guide only and all yardage requirements are approximate. However, additional yardage may vary due to fabric layout, the design to which it is being applied, and/or the quantity of items being ordered. In the event of unusual repeats or fabric design, please contact us to determine if a full width sample is required to provide a more accurate determination of yardage requirements.
