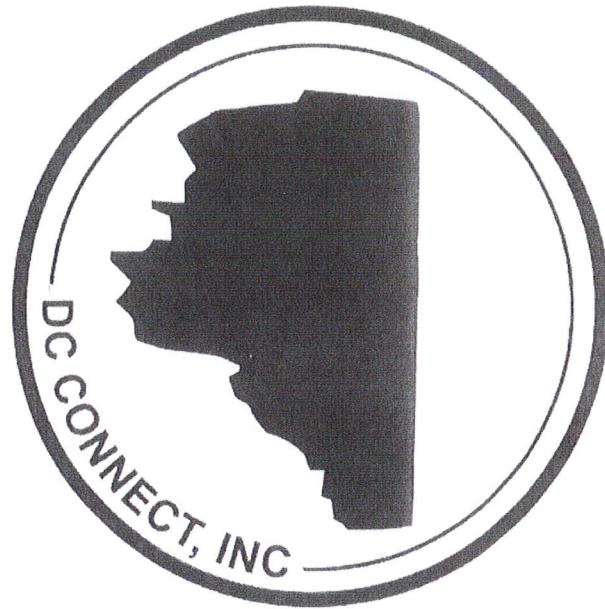

Eligibility: patient must be uninsured, annual household income cannot be more than 300% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, cannot have substantial cash assets, cannot have declined health insurance through an employer, must live in Novant Health service area, and the application/supporting documentation must be submitted to the hospital business office or financial counseling department.
