



Application and Eligibility

Application must be received by September 30, 2026

Year-end Awards are based on an average of 4 best scores at 3 a minimum of 3 shows for a horse and rider combination. Lower scores will be dropped. A level award can only be won twice by the same horse/rider combination, except in Eventing and/or Western. Registration is free for members, \$25 for non-members.

Level awards offered:

Leadline	For children 8 and under and special needs of any age.
Introductory	Any combination of tests. May only cross qualify with Starter W/T/C.
Starter W/T/C	Intro C and Training 1, One test must be T-1. May only cross qualify with Intro.
Training	At least one of the scores must be in test 3. Once a pair becomes eligible for Training Level awards, placings at lower levels will be forfeited.
First	At least one of the scores must be in test 3
Second +	Any combination of tests at Second level or above. Special Award for highest placing pair using majority Second Level scores.
Eventing	Any combination of tests - may move through the levels.
Western	Any combination of tests - may move through the levels.
