# HELLO!



When planning your wedding, it's important to consider the photography timeline. A skilled photographer can help you create a detailed timeline that takes into account all the important moments you want to capture, including both candid and posed shots. This timeline will help ensure that you have enough time to get all the photos you want, without feeling rushed or overwhelmed on your beautiful day.



60-90  
MINUTES**BRIDAL DETAILS + CURATED FLATLAYS**

allow for a minimum of 60-90 minutes to craft these beautiful and intricate photos.

30-60  
MINUTES**GETTING DRESSED**

Allow for plenty of time to get dressed, have your attendants ready to help with veil, shoes, jewelry and those candid moments in between!

30-560  
MINUTES**INDIVIDUAL BRIDE + GROOM PORTRAITS**

If you are considering more than one location for bridal portraits or you must travel to a secondary location, add a buffer of time to ensure you have time to document this moment as a bride.

30-60  
MINUTES**FIRST LOOK + COUPLE PORTRAITS**

Are you considering more than one location for these portraits? if so, add an extra 30 minutes or more. At a minimum allow for 30-40 minutes for these portraits of you as a couple.

30-45  
MINUTES**BRIDAL PARTY FORMAL + CANDID PORTRAITS**

Allow for 30-45 moments to capture full bridal party, then individual photos and bride + bridesmaids and groom + groomsmen portraits.

30-60  
MINUTES**FORMAL FAMILY PORTRAITS**

For large family grouping, consider a minimum of one hour for these portraits. Typical portraits take a minimum of 3-5 minutes per grouping.

**SUNSET  
PHOTOS****10-20 MINUTES**

For spring/summer weddings sunset is longer while fall /winter weddings the sunset timing is brief and short. Set aside time and begin at least 15 minutes before the sunset time.

**FIRST LOOKS****10-15 MINUTES**

FIRST LOOKS WITH PARENTS / BRIDAL PARTY

**RECEPTION  
REVEAL****10-20 MINUTES**

Once your reception decor is complete, your planner will escort you to your reception space and we will photograph your reaction.

**GIFT  
EXCHANGE****10-20 MINUTES**

We will set time aside to allow you and your groom or family time for your gift exchange and capture these portraits.

**ROBE/PJ  
CANDID  
PHOTOS****20-30 MINUTES**

Planning on popping some champagne and taking cute getting ready photos with you and your bridal squad? Or candid photos or groom + groomsmen before formally dressing?

**SPARKLER +.  
SEND OFFS****10-15 MINUTES**

Sparkler exits are the most time consuming due to the logistics of lighting the sparklers. Allow for a minimum of 10-15 minutes before the end of your reception time to place your guests, light the sparkles and photograph these portraits. Due to weather and wind these may take a little longer, adjust your time accordingly.
