Discipleship Bands are gatherings of 2-4 people that meet weekly for intentional disciple making. Band gatherings are Spirit-led through reflection and sharing from Bible reading and spiritual practices.

The goal of these Bands is to help members be with Jesus, become like Jesus, and do what he did.

soaps Reading Method

Scripture

Highlight any word, phrase, or verse that resonates with your spirit

Observation

Put this verse in your own words and make any observations

Application

Interpret what the passage might mean and how it could apply to you

Prayer

Close your time by writing out a prayer to God

Share

Share it with a friend, spouse, or neighbor!

Gathering Agenda

Bible Reading

- 1. How many days did you read the Bible this week?
- 2. How did you hear God speak this week? Share a journal entry.
- 3. Did you have any questions from your reading?

Accountability

- 1. How is it with your soul? (Prov. 4:23)
- 2. What are you celebrating? (1 Thess. 5:11)
- 3. Where are you struggling or being tempted?
- 4. How has the Holy Spirit been speaking to you?
- 5. Do you have any sin to confess?
- 6. Have you been angry, fearful, or anxious? Why?
- 7. Do you need to reconcile with anyone?
- 8. How well are you loving those whom God has placed in your life? (James 2:8)

Prayer for Others

- 1. Who are you praying for this week and why?
- 2. Who are you praying would surrender their life to Jesus?
- 3. Who is someone you could start a discipleship group with in the future?

Close in prayer for these requests and one another.
